

MERCHANTS TO INSURE FIREMEN AND POLICE

Police and firemen in the village of New Trier township are to receive adequate protection for themselves and their families as the result of action taken by the New Trier Commercial association Monday of this week in adopting measures to provide life and accident insurance for men employed in those capacities.

The contemplated protection comes under the designation of group insurance. Funds to defray the expense of this protection for municipal employees are to be realized at a benefit entertainment or play to be given soon under the auspices of the Commercial association, it is announced.

Police and fire departments in New Trier are not under civil service regulation and consequently the members are not beneficiaries of pension funds or adequate protection in the event of accident or illness. The insurance contemplated by the Commercial association would secure adequate protection for the men and their families.

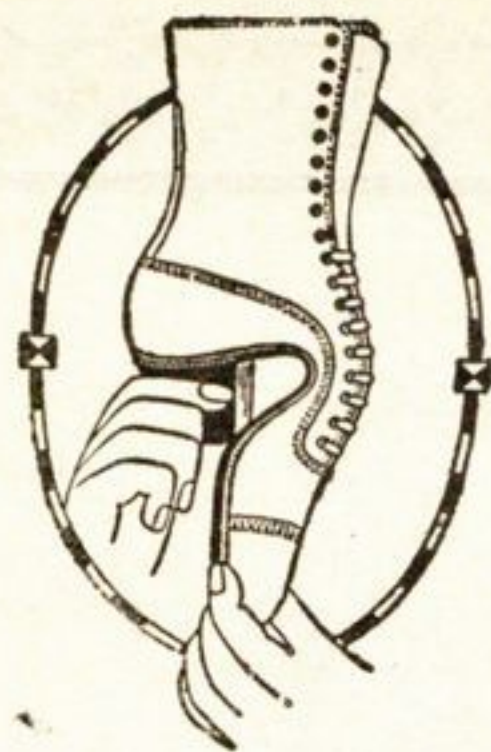

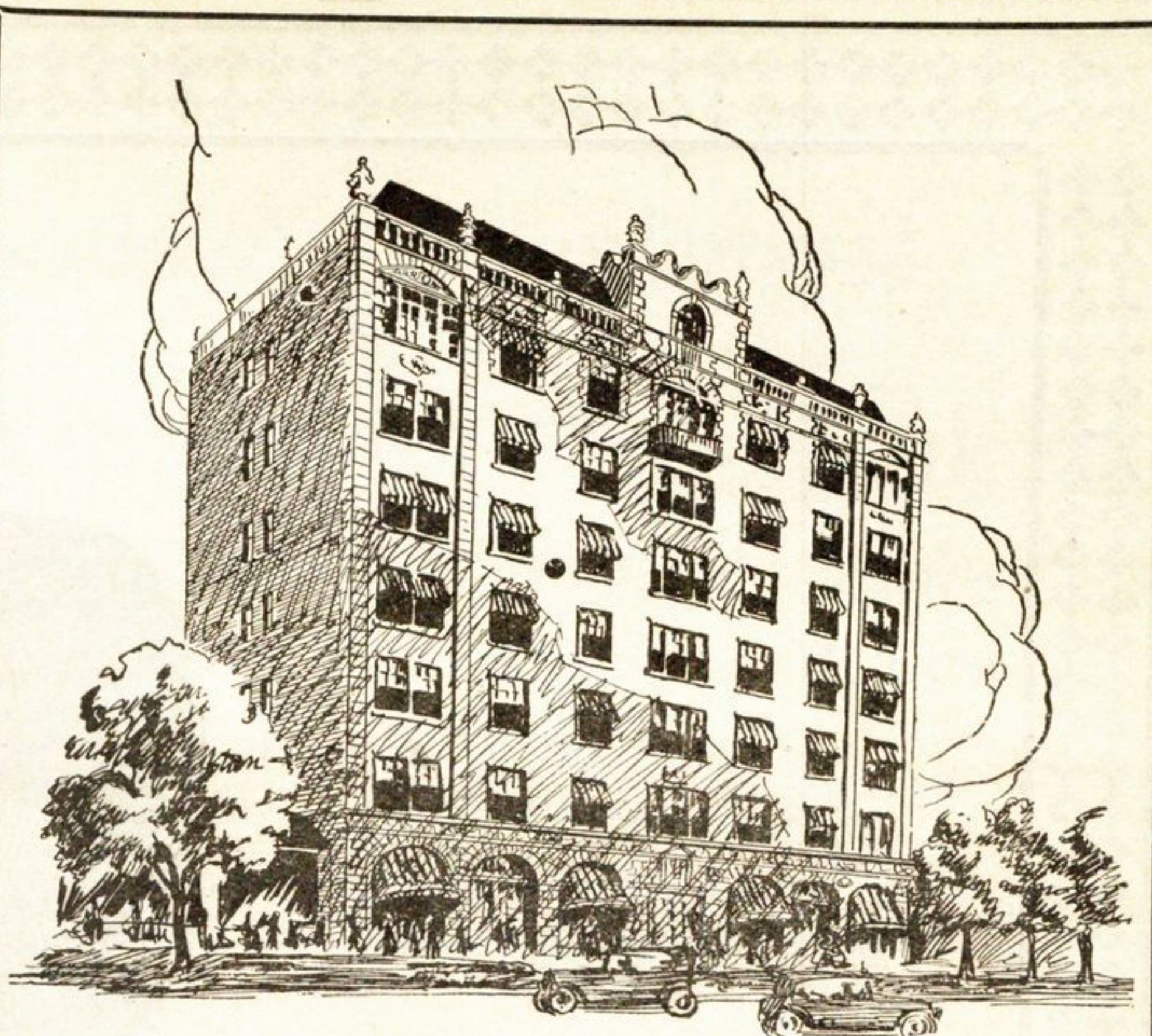
