

## MYSTERIOUS BULLET INJURES TRUCKMAN

Robert Conley Shot in Left  
Leg Monday While Driving  
Grocery Truck

### POLICE INVESTIGATE

Fail to Determine Source of  
Shot

Robert Conley, 1016 Spruce street, truck driver for a local grocery, is in St. Francis hospital suffering from the effects of a bullet wound inflicted under mysterious circumstances Monday afternoon of this week while Conley was driving along Rosewood avenue at Starr place.

"I suddenly felt a sting in my thigh," Conley explained to the police, and was startled, an instant later, to see blood stains on my trousers."

#### No Trace of Shooter

Examination disclosed a bullet wound in the man's thigh, and he was rushed to the hospital while police instituted a careful but futile search in the vicinity of the shooting.

X-ray examination at the hospital showed that the bullet had pierced Conley's right thigh and cut two and one-half inches into his left leg above the knee.

#### Called Child's Prank

In commenting on the accident Chief of Police Peterson expressed the opinion that the bullet, of 22-calibre, came from the gun of some child playing in the vicinity. Parents should understand," he said, "that giving of firearms and air guns to children is a very dangerous practice, which not only endangers their own children but also puts in jeopardy the lives of others. It is strictly against the village ordinance to use any kind of a gun or even a sling-shot in the village limits."

I realize though, the time has not yet come to take that up, but I believe when you can do it you will reach hundreds and thousands who possibly would never be able to take advantage of your service in Braille.

"I do not mean to relax in any way the work done in Braille. That will always come first.

"I was greatly surprised and pleased to see the number of books you have already brought out, and when you are writing won't you let me know just how your press works, and if it is giving satisfaction, and if you would not mind, telling me the cost of it.

#### Would Help Cause

"I am going to make a mention in the next magazine of some of the facts in the circular, and if there is anything else you would like brought before the blind through our magazine, kindly let us know, and we will

be glad to give it publicity, and do not hesitate to call on us at any time if there is anything we can do to help you in your work.

"I have been thinking of giving a little article to one of our local magazines, telling just what you and the people of Winnetka have done, for this would stimulate other people and communities, and induce them to take up a similar work. I don't mean, of course, a printing work for the blind, but some other work for the blind or the crippled or other handicapped, and I would like to know if I could

have a picture of yourself and your good wife for this article.

"I know you are not seeking notoriety, but if through such an article you can stimulate and encourage others to do something worth while in their community, I know you will not object."

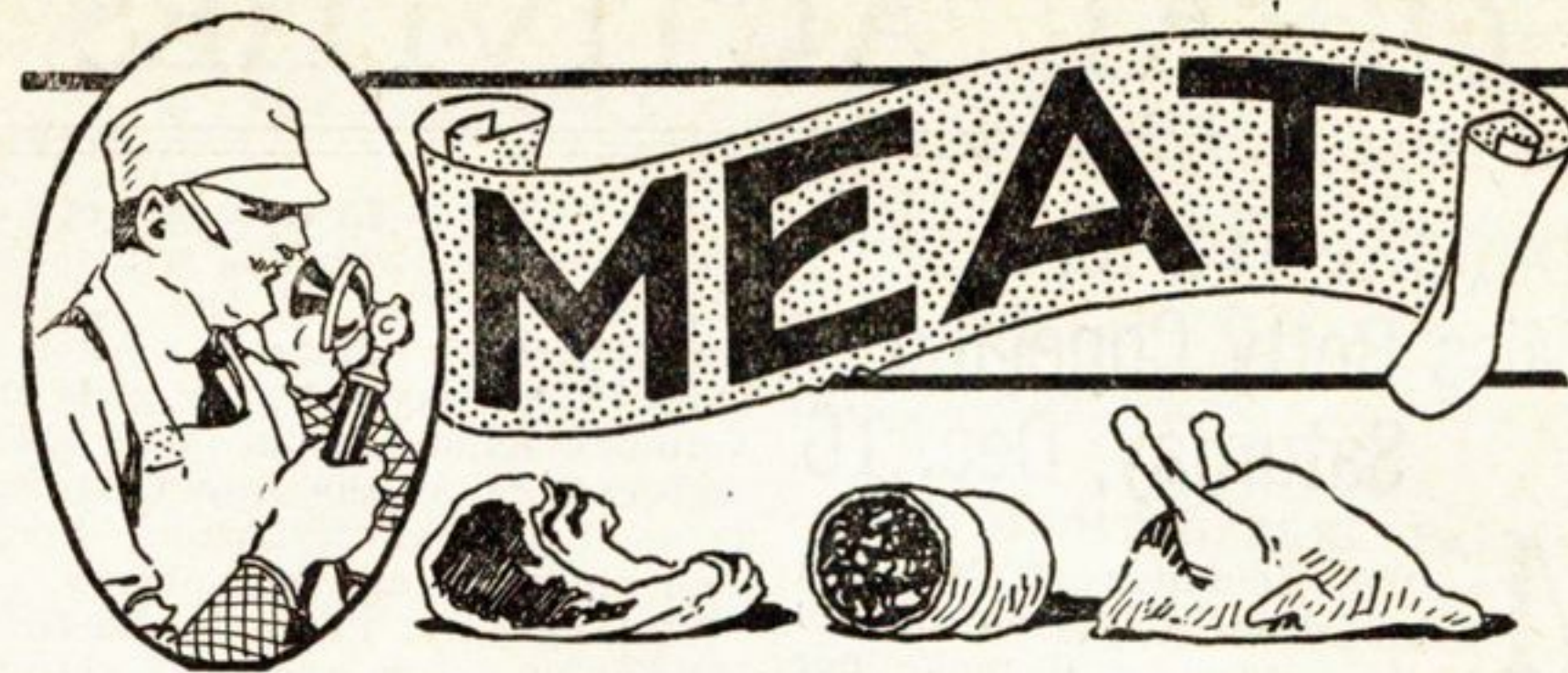

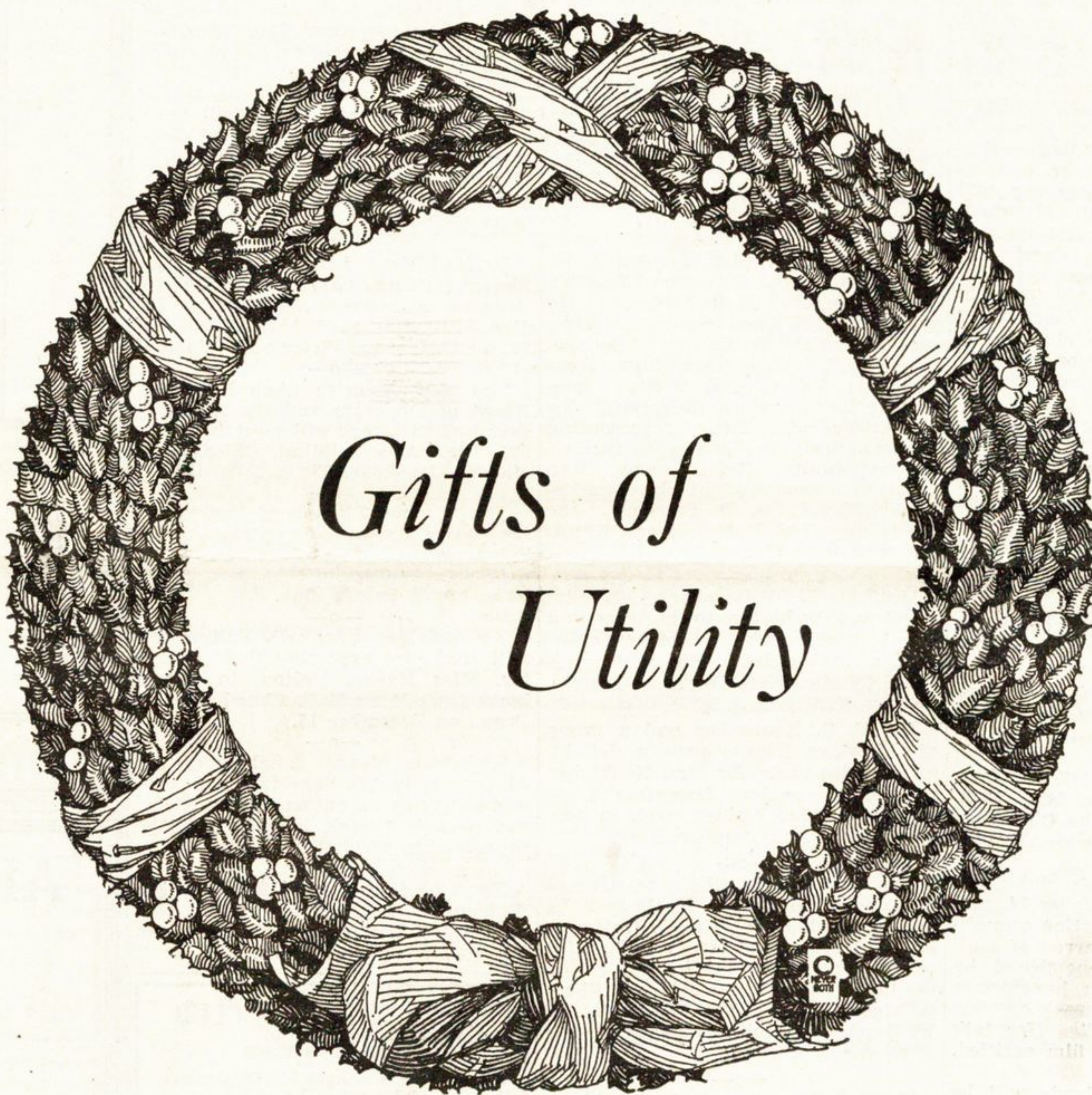
