

\$17,000 Residence Leads

Building Permit Grants

At the head of the list of building permits issued last week, which authorizes the construction of buildings valued at \$38,775, stands a permit authorizing F. Gadenhead to erect a two-story frame and stucco residence at 1056 Ely street at an estimated cost of \$17,000.

Next in line comes two permits granted to J. W. Jackson, who will build houses at 933 and 922 North avenue. The houses will be two-story buildings of brick, frame and tile construction. The estimated cost of the first is \$8,000, and that of the latter is \$7,000. H. I. Brewer, 1077 Fig street, was granted a permit to erect a bungalow at an estimated cost of \$6,100.

Permits for the construction of private garages were issued to E. M. Maddox, 705 Oak street, and to H. C. Sanders, 898 Ash street.

Youth Struck by Train Here Dies at Evanston Hospital

Robert Wilson, Winnetka, who was struck by a Milwaukee electric while crossing the tracks at Elm street, Winnetka, on November 27, died in the Evanston Hospital Sunday. An inquest was ordered held at the hospital today. Wilson, according to Winnetka police, was alighting from a southbound car and had passed behind it when struck by a train ap-

proaching on the northbound track. He was rushed to the Evanston Hospital in the police ambulance following the accident.

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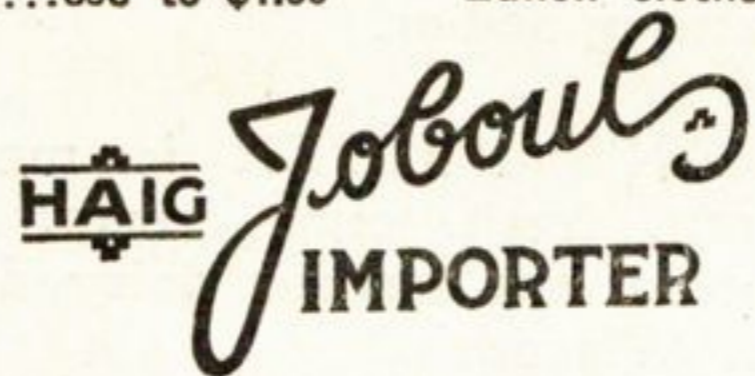
