Talented Singer Appears as Soloist in Second Orchestral Association Program

IN CHICAGO DEBUT

"Little Symphony" Orchestra Will Play

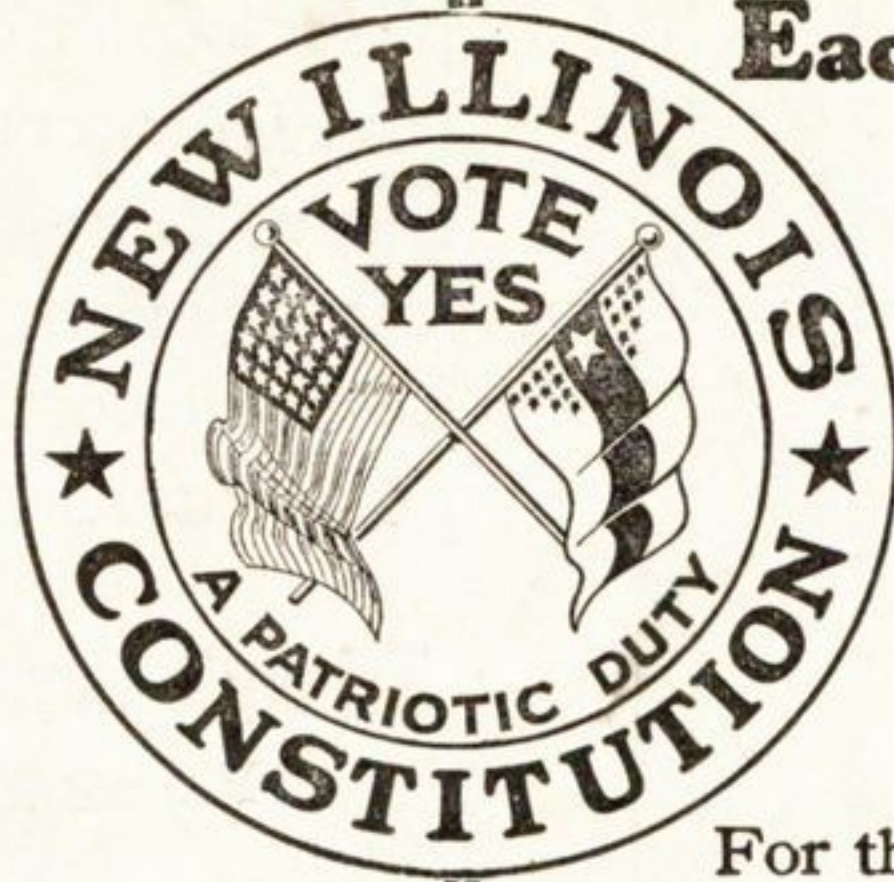
The second concert, Tuesday evening, December 12, of the orchestral series by The Little Symphony Orchestra of Chicago, George Dasch, conductor, at the high school auditorium under the auspices of The New Trier Orchestral association, will mark the Chicago debut of Estelle Hughes, soprano.

Miss Hughes is a Philadelphian, and last season leaped from the obscurity of an ambitious and talented

music student to a place of eminence among singers of the day. In the spring of 1919 she was the successful candidate for the medal offered by Leopold Stokowski, with the additional honor of an appearance at the regular concerts of the Philadelphia orchestra at the Academy of Music. In the season's announcements her name appeared side by side with the greatest artists of the day, and her appearance was marked by an enthusiasm only accorded those who have "arrived." She sang two of the great coloratura arias, the Mad Scene

from "Lucia di Lammermoor" and Rossini's aria from "The Barber of Seville," with ease and fluency. Her voice is one of great beauty and of unusual flexibility, and she has a personality whose chief attraction is one of simplicity and marked naturalness of manner.
