WANT AN ORPHAN?




This child represents one of the large group of little folks at the Lake Bluff Orphanage who are to be brought to Wilmette on Christmas Day.

NEW TRIER DEFEATS PROPOSED BASIC LAW

In a ballot that was so light as to be almost negligible in certain districts, New Trier township Tuesday joined with the balance of the state in defeating the proposed new Illinois state constitution.

Figures in New Trier's vote were unofficially as follows: For the proposed constitution, 1,499; against, 2,532.

In one district in Wilmette the vote was tie on the question, 64 in favor of adoption and a like number against. In another district in the township not a single favorable ballot was registered, it was stated.

Proponents of the proposed basic law had counted on New Trier, Evanston and other country town districts to join with downstate in counteracting the expected heavy Chicago ballot against the measure. The result was a complete surprise even to the most optimistic of the opponents

of the proposed basic law. Roswell E. Mason Democrat of Winnetka, and Frederic R. De Young, Republican, were favored in the local vote for the judgeships which would have been created under the provisions of the new constitution. With the defeat of the constitution the judges' election is without significance.
