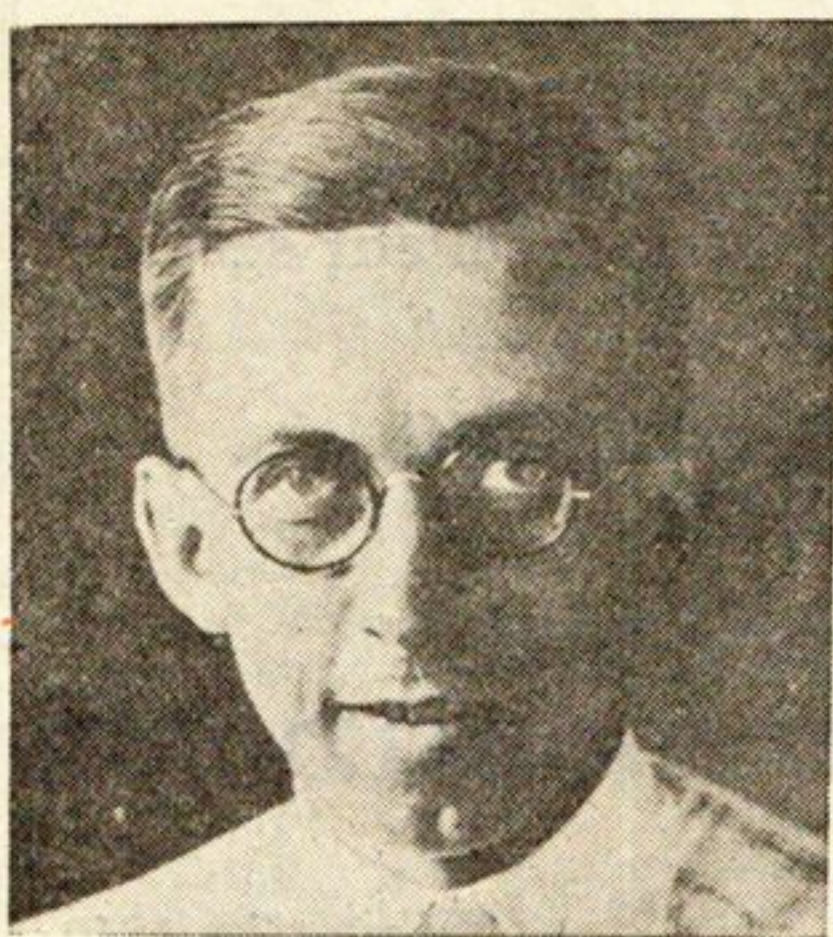


**THAT FATHERLY SMILE**
