

Skokie Cagers Top Boys From Country Day School

Slight Lull In Building Permits During This Week

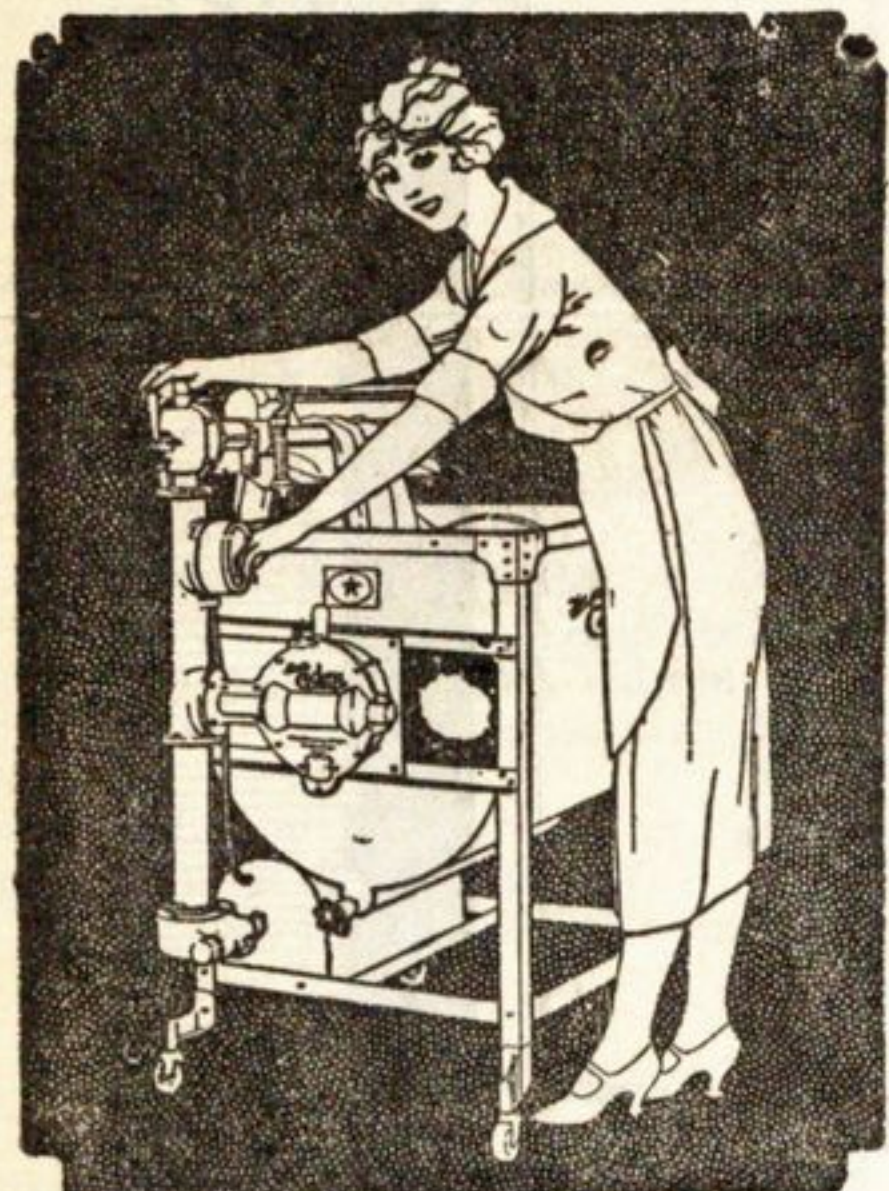

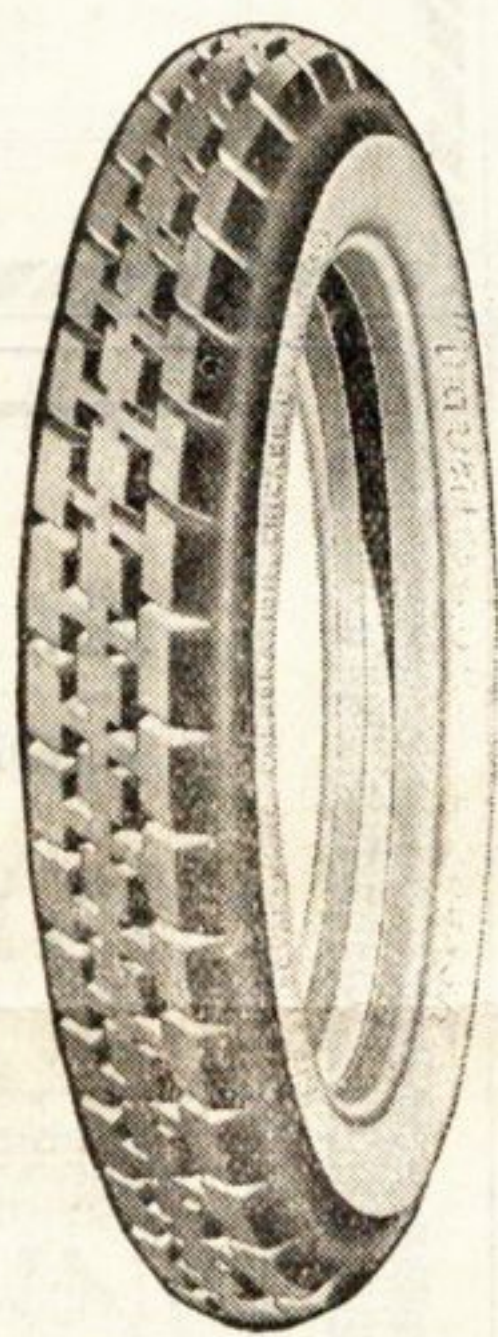

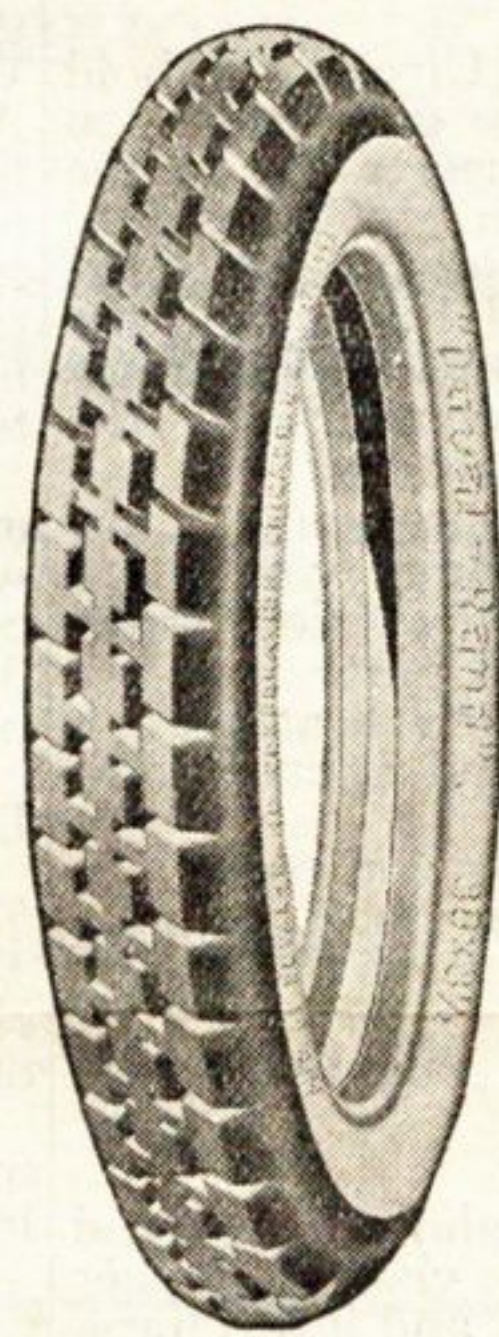
