Cellist To Give Special
Program

Dr. Hugh Black, one of the best known preachers of modern times, will be the speaker at the Wilmette Sunday Evening club on March 18. The special program of music will be given by Carl Brueckner, cellist, with the Chicago Symphony orchestra, who recently appeared before the Sunday Evening club with the Philharmonic quartet.

Noted as Author

Dr. Black came to the United States from Scotland in 1906. He was born and educated in Scotland and became pastor of the Sherwood church at Paisley in 1891. He became the pastor of St. George United Free Church in

Edinburgh in 1896. He is the author of many well known books, including, "The Dream of Youth," "Friendship," "Practice of Self Culture," "Happiness," "Lest We Forget" and "Edinburgh Sermons."

Dr. Black is a powerful speaker whose pulpit influence has been felt throughout this country and in England.

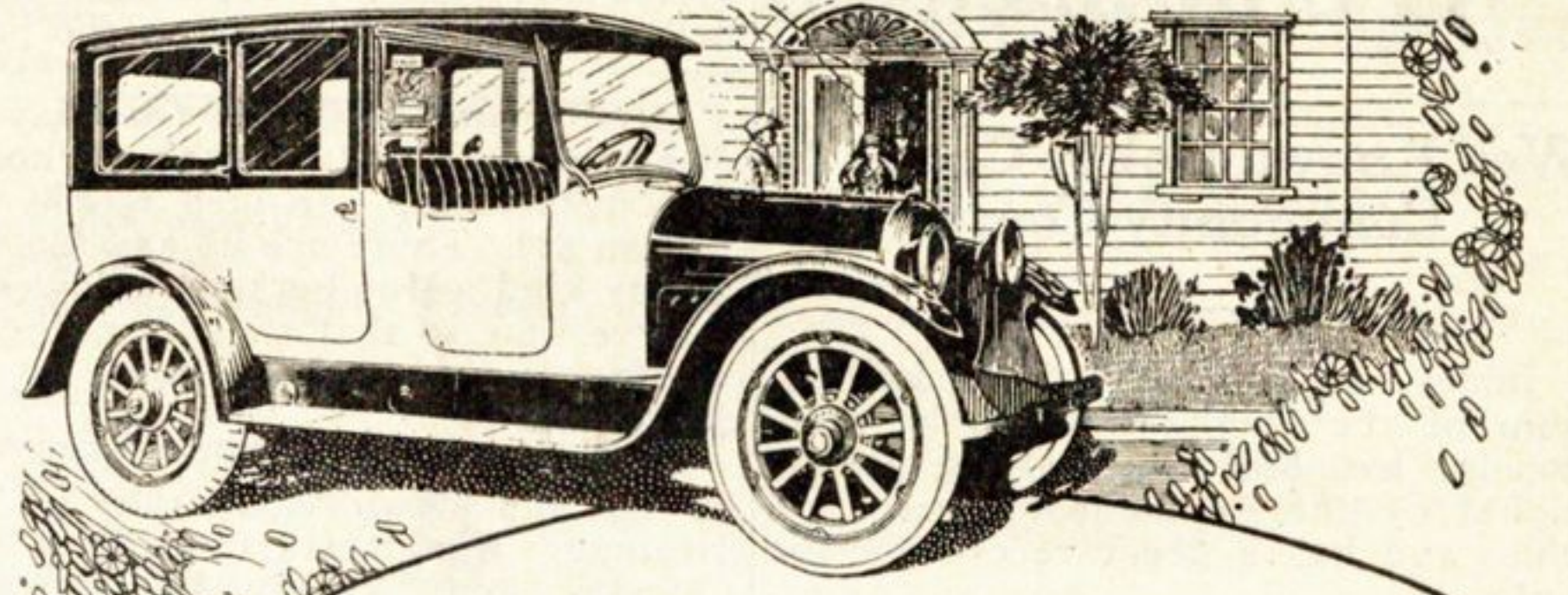
The address was the third of series of special Y. M. C. A., Lenten services

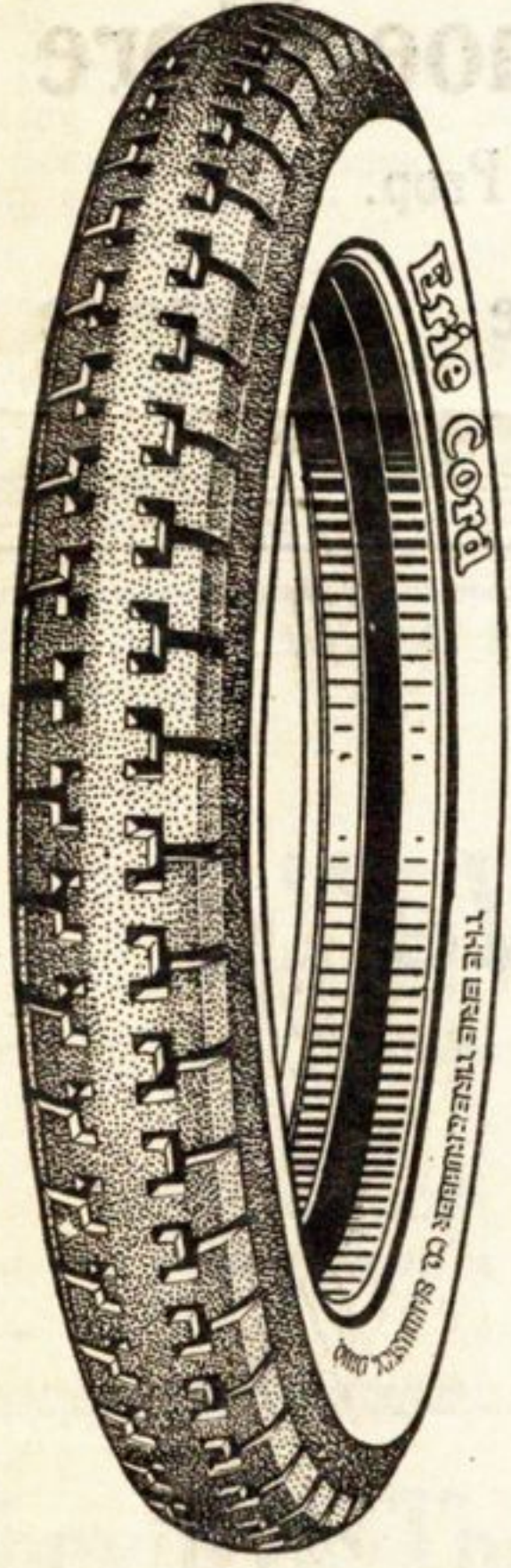
