meetings have been held as special affairs. The attendance from October first last to March twenty-sixth has been almost 85,000; and 229 volunteer workers have given time and effort to make the service of these groups successful. The Director estimates that the total attendance during the twelve years of the House exceeds one million.

"Indeed, to the many folk who make some feature or element of Community House a part of their daily life, there is no need to try to justify this institution. A mere reminder is sufficient to secure the renewal of their financial, as well as moral support.

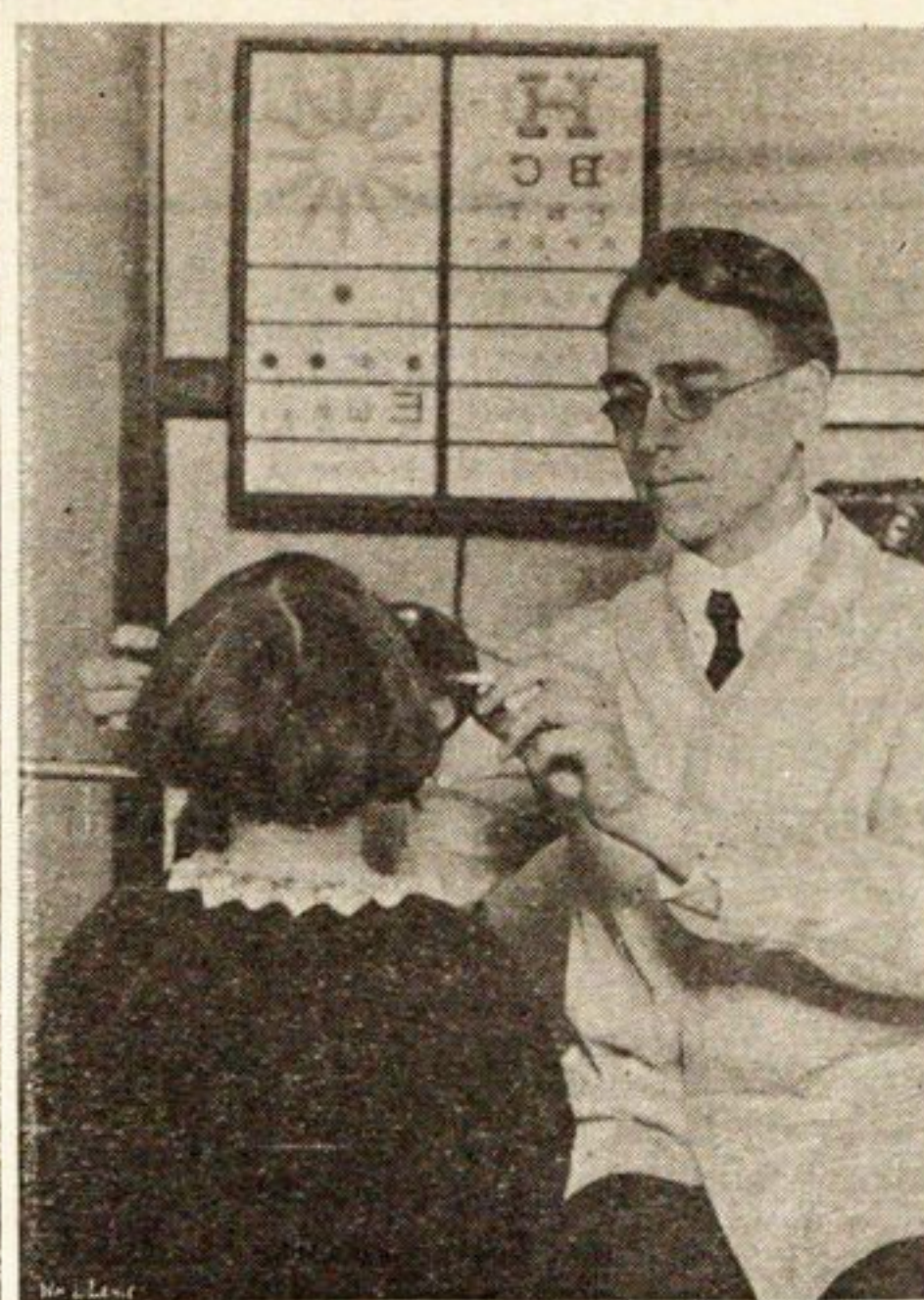

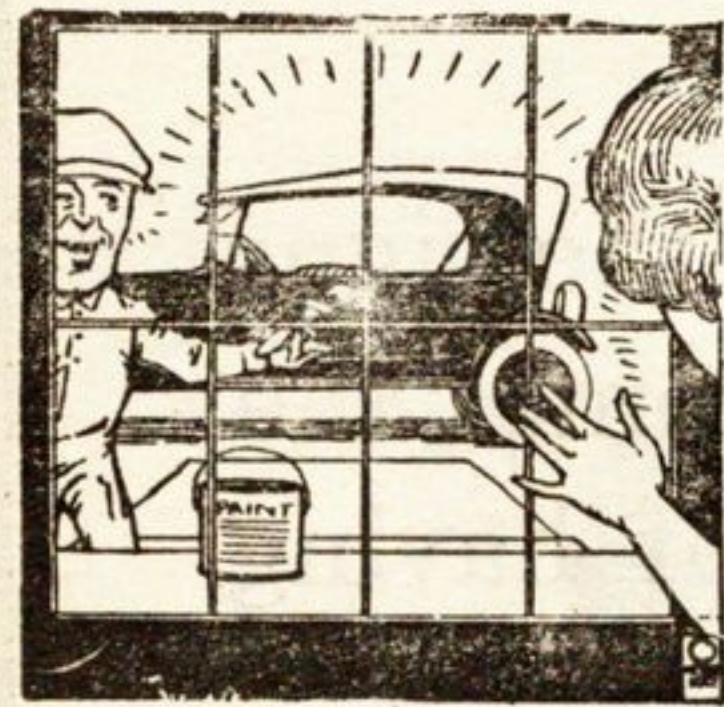
