

HELP WANTED TO EXPEDITE MAILS

Postmaster Adams Cites Few "Post Office Helps" for Winnetka Residents

SHOWS TIME LEAKS

Urges Care in Addressing All Mails

Postmaster Elmer E. Adams, in his effort to expedite the mail service in Winnetka this week dispatched to the Talk editorial rooms some "Post Office Helps" for patrons of the local post office.

Winnetkans should be keenly interested in the accompanying direct "shots:"

"Post Office Helps"

"Have your mail addressed to Street and Number or Post Office Box.

"Have your return address on all mail sent.

"Have your Parcels well packed, well tied with stout string and tied in such a way that the string cannot be slipped off.

"Don't think you are the only one receiving mail at this office.

"Don't think you are the only Adams, Brown, Smith or Jones in town; there are others and they may think they are as well known and as important as you.

Use Street and Number

"Don't have your mail addressed to some pet name you call your house instead of street and number, (such as Chimney Nook, Seven Gables); nobody but the old carrier on your route knows how many Chimney nooks or Gables you have on your house.

"Remember that mail property addressed receives first consideration, and that the matter without Street address has to wait for directory service. This takes time and is an absolute waste.

"We have a serious condition to

overcome at this time owing to the large deficiency in the Post Office appropriation, which cannot be relieved before July 1. The employees of this office are doing all in their power to give you the best of service possible under these conditions and earnestly request the patrons to help in every way possible to make this task as easy as they can by using more care in having their mail property addressed.

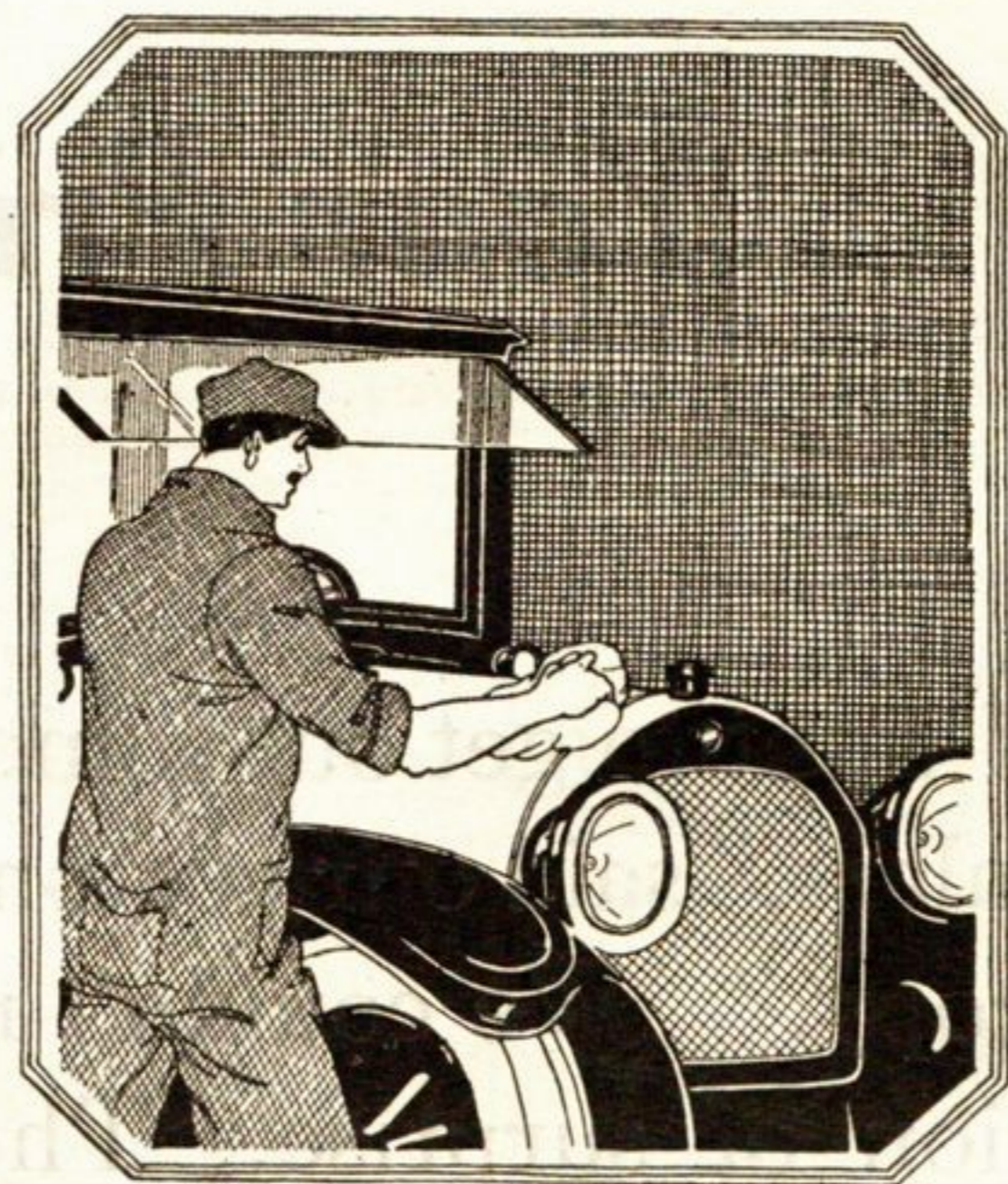

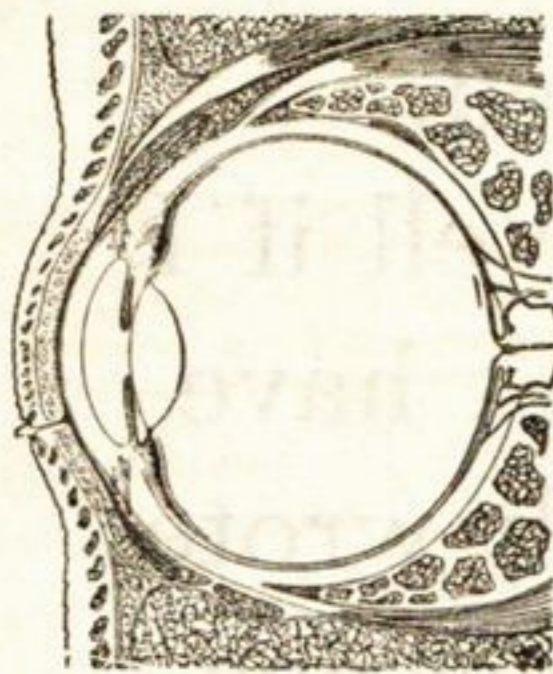
