

## RAPID SALE OF BAKULE TICKETS

Anticipate Enthusiastic Reception for Czecho-Slovakian Songsters

CONCERT HERE MAY 14

Crippled Children Demonstrate Handiwork

Out of gratitude to the American Junior Red Cross The Bakule School Unit of the Czecho-Slovak Red Cross will appear in the Jane Kuppenheimer Memorial hall, Skokie school, Monday afternoon, May 14, at 2 o'clock, to demonstrate the work which is being done for the crippled children of the Bakule school, to sing to their friends in America the beloved songs of their home land and to demonstrate some of the folk dances of Czecho-Slovakia.

### Predict Great Reception

The chorus will be well received in Winnetka as was indicated last Wednesday when it was announced that all of the children's tickets had been sold, and that only a very few adult tickets remained on sale. It is expected that the spacious Jane Kuppenheimer hall will be taxed to its capacity.

The Bakule Chorus comes from Prague Czecho-slovakia. It is composed mostly of crippled children who are being cared for by the Bakule school and are being taught how to overcome the handicaps that are theirs. Examples of the beautiful handiwork that the crippled children can do will be on exhibition at the Skokie school. Some of the work, it is said, is remarkably delicate.

### Sing Native Melodies

In addition to exhibiting their mechanical and artistic ability the European children will sing folk songs and native melodies, and will demonstrate some of the Czech folk dances. Classical music will also have a place on the program.

The Bakule Unit's American tour is being conducted by the American Red Cross. The appearance in Winnetka is made possible by virtue of the personal friendship of Carleton W. Washburne, superintendent of schools, with Mr. Bakule, the principal of the school.

Other performances are given only in the larger cities.

### U. of I. Stadium Work Now Proceeding Rapidly

They're speeding up on the construction of the great University of Illinois Memorial Stadium, whose imposing red skeleton of steel is steadily pushing itself skyward. With six months in which to complete the seats for the opening game—the Chicago-Illinois football battle on November 3 — the contractors have squared away for the drive.

Every bit of structural steel is at hand and it is expected to be in place by the end of the month. The huge girders which will support the balcony are going into place at an average of almost one a day. The structure will contain 2,700 tons of steel.
