Modern Comedy

The play itself is "The Gypsy Trail," a modern romantic comedy by Robert Housum. It concerns itself principally with one Frances Raymond, a charming girl, prosaic and not in the least unusual. She lives a humdrum sort of life and longs for romance. A young man in love with Frances is Ned, just as prosaic and humdrum as she. Then comes Michael, a reporter, an adventurer, a wanderer. Ned conceives the brilliant scheme of kidnapping Frances, and gets Michael to help him. Then, in some way or other, Michael, who has no desire whatever to marry and settle down, finds himself engaged to Frances.

There you have the beginning of the play. It is cleverly worked out, and altogether pleasing. The sets are attractive, as usual, and the casts are working hard. Tickets will be put on sale soon. Don't forget the dates, June 1 and 2.
