

## \$10 A WEEK AT CAMP ROOSEVELT

Applications Must Be Made Before July 1

Ten dollars a week is what it costs a boy to attend Camp Roosevelt, conducted under the auspices of the Chicago Board of Education and the War Department of the U. S. Government, and open to boys from all parts of the country. The camp is located on Silver Lake, near LaPorte, Indiana. Enrollments early in June indicate the national reputation this camp has built up, and applications and inquiries are pouring into the headquarters from every state in the Union.

The reason for this is plain. Camp Roosevelt is open to any American boy of good character, from the age of 10 and up. It offers, at low cost, the opportunities which the finest private camps in the country have to offer. The pre-war basis of little over a dollar a day per cadet is one of its most remarkable features. The balance necessary for the maintenance of this large institution is supplied by public-spirited Chicago citizens, who yearly contribute the necessary funds. Major F. L. Beals, U. S. A., commanding the camp, is in personal touch with all boys under his charge. They respect and admire him as a leader, a friend and counsellor rather than a stern unapproachable commander. His long experience in boy education has made him an ideal head for such a big, democratic American institution, and he is never too busy to go thoroughly into each individual boy's case.

The three divisions of the camp, (summer school R. O. T. C. and Junior) give all boys a chance to be placed where they will have the most fun and enjoy the greatest amount of benefit.

Applications for attendance will be accepted at the Chicago Board of Education, 460 S. State St., until June 30.

## LOCAL MEN GET U. OF I. DEGREES

Wilmette, Kenilworth and Glencoe Represented

Ninety-one counties of the state will be represented among the 1623 who will receive degrees from the University of Illinois at the fifty-second annual commencement of that institution on Monday June 11. This number includes all colleges and departments at both Urbana and Chicago. Some 225 more degrees will be conferred by the University this year than last. Included in the above degrees are 159 advanced—Master's of Art and Doctor's of Philosophy—granted to those persons who have pursued study and research work more than the required four years.

Commencement activities started Friday with Class Day. On Saturday the annual Alumni day celebration, when several thousand old grads return to the campus for a brief visit, focuses the attention of grads and visitors. On Sunday the baccalaureate address will be given at 4 o'clock in the afternoon by Bishop C. P. Anderson, of Chicago.

The fifty-second annual commencement takes place Monday morning at 10:30 o'clock. Dr. David Kinley, president of the university, will be the speaker. The degrees will be conferred immediately at the close of his address.

Among those who will be granted degrees, exclusive of the Medical schools in Chicago are: Cromwell Bowen, Donald Mills Remb and John Marmon Rindell, of Wilmette; Arthur Burman Durham and Edmund Strother Phelps of Kenilworth; Max Disette Englehart Arthur Lawrence Fox and Edward Henry Stachel of Glencoe.
