## Northwestern R. R. Reports 100 Percent on Time Record

A 100 per cent on time arrival of all trains between Chicago and Milwaukee and between Chicago and St. Paul-Minneapolis was maintained during the month of May, according to an announcement by operating officials of the Northwestern railway today. Their

record further shows that out of a total of 2,609 through passenger trains on lines east of the Missouri river, an on-time arrival was maintained with 2,536, equivalent to a percentage of 97 per cent.
