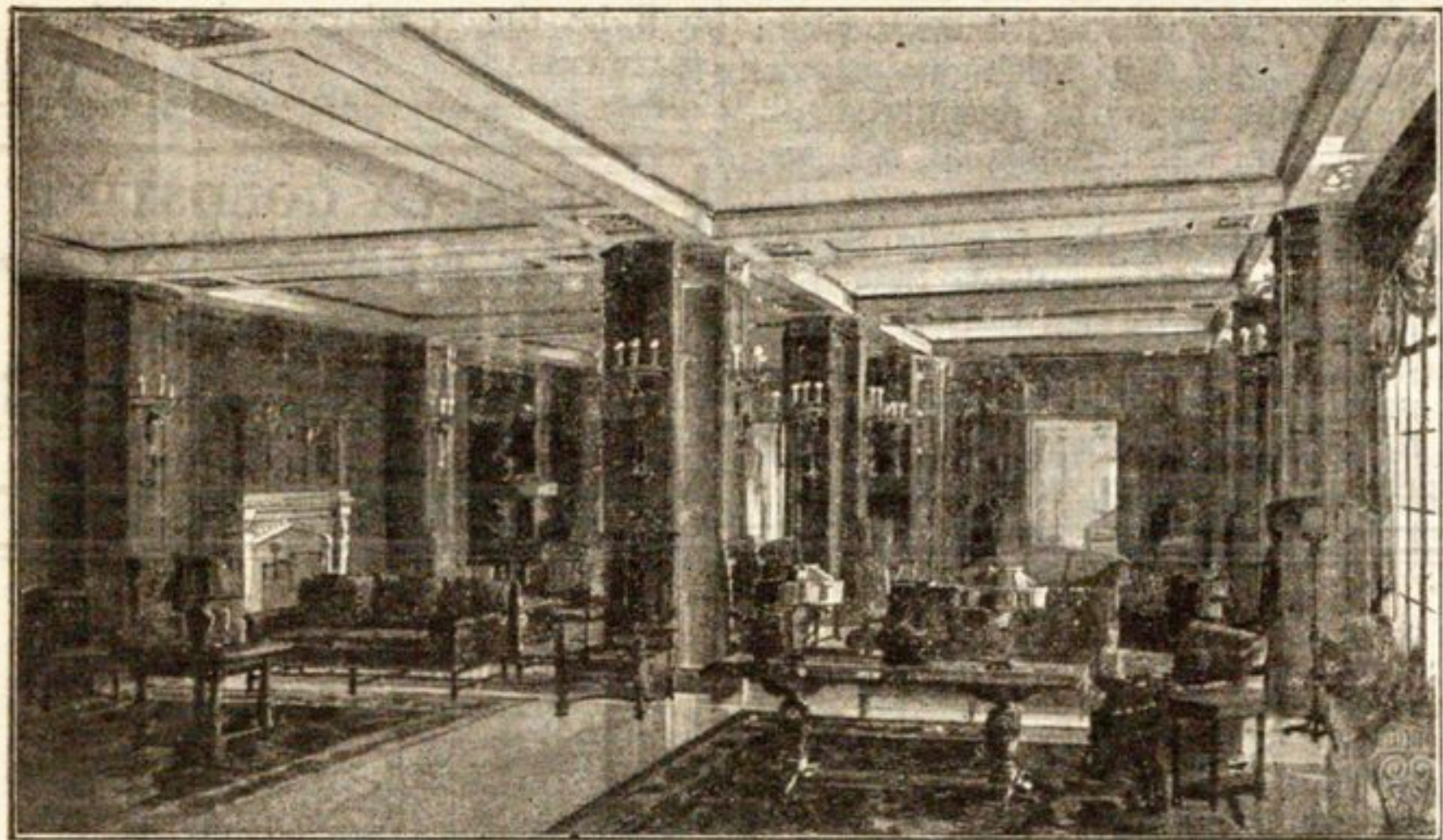


Comfort and Elegance of Home

"I found that the growing use of sports wear had had a decided influence upon much apparel," he said, "and of course, this is of particular appeal in suburban communities like the north shore, where sports apparel is exceedingly popular."

"The use of camel's hair fabric, perhaps the finest service fabric ever produced, has particularly accentuated the value of street wear and sports wear in both skirts, coats and dresses.

"More formal fabric coats are designed in straight silhouettes of high lustre fabrics with large rich fur sets of Biatka squirrel, platinum wolf and fox. Red fox is one of the newest modes."

Satin faced fabric is the dominant mode for dresses, he said, and poiret twill is a recurrent vogue this autumn.

"It doesn't seem possible," commented Keaton.

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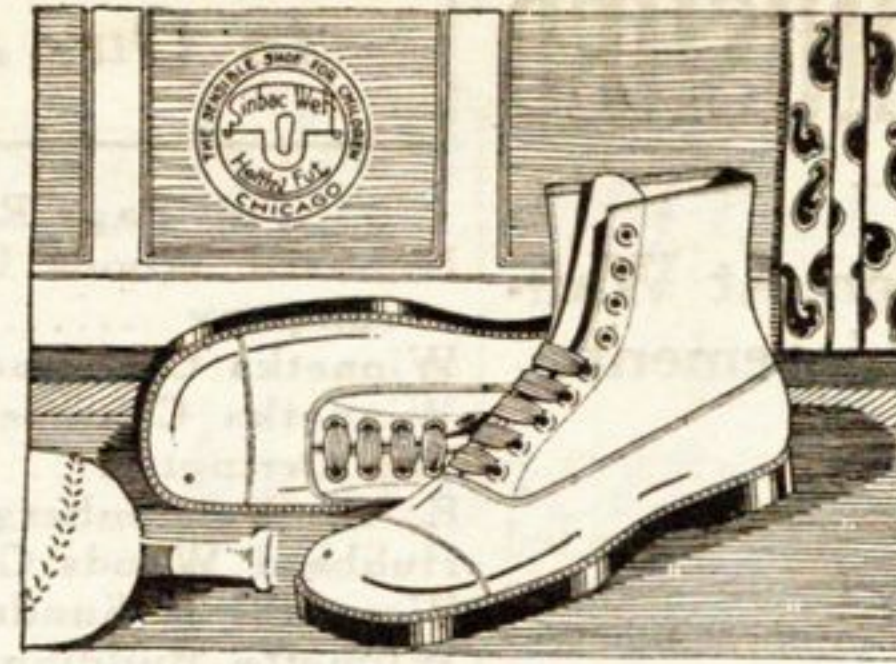
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
