Prepare Red Lights For Through Street Corners

When the Chicago ordinance creating the new right-of-way streets was enacted, it was thought sufficient merely to mark the intersection of such streets with a

"stop" sign. So many motorists, however, have disregarded this sign, or have overlooked it, that Coroner Wolff and other city officials were advocating the discontinuance of these through thoroughfares. Many of the accidents which have occurred this year have been attrib-

utable to the carelessness of automobile drivers at these intersections.

This condition, however, shortly is to be remedied. The North Shore Motor club, together with the Illinois Auto club, has been instrumental in hastening the work on the 3,500 lighting globes

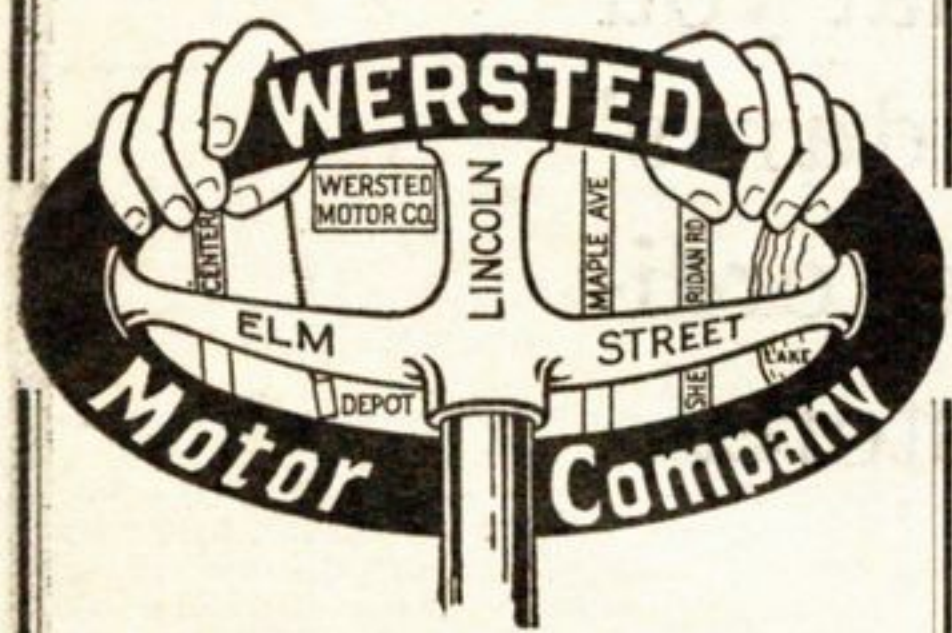
which are to supplement the "stop" signs at the corners. These globes will be red, and when illuminated at night can easily be seen at a distance. It is hoped that their installation will appreciably cut down the number of accidents occurring at these points.
