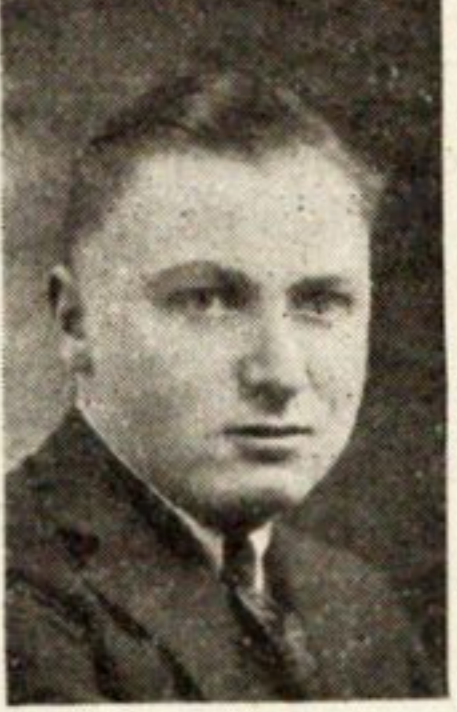
Make Offer to Winnetka Organizations for Appearance of "13th Chair"

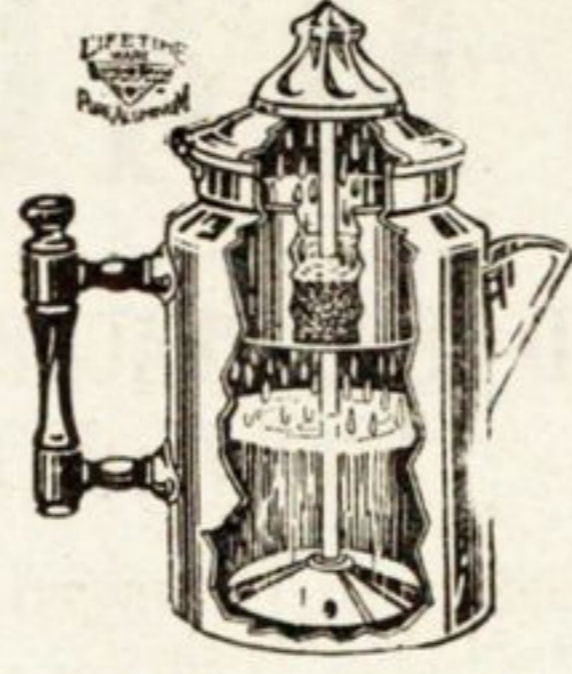
