

## PLAN ROTARY FOR WILMETTE

Unit to Be Established Here Soon

Wilmette is to have a Rotary club. Assurances were given this week that plans are nearing completion for the establishment of a unit of the Rotary International in the village. All that remains necessary is the official sanction of the Chicago and Oak Park clubs, Evanston having approved the establishment of a Wilmette Rotary. Chicago and Oak Park are soon to take favorable action.

Plans for a Wilmette Rotary have been in process of formulation for several months and it is expected that definite steps toward organization will be taken in the very near future.

Chicago is the International headquarters of this great organization which comprises in its membership leading commercial and professional men in every part of the world.

The Rotary comes under the classification of luncheon clubs. Its members meet at luncheon one day every week, discuss questions of mutual interest and formulate plans for the promotion of community welfare projects. It aims to promote a spirit of fellowship among business and professional men which, everywhere, has proved a remarkable influence for good in the community. Its members are pledged to uprightness in all their business dealings.

Last summer the citizens of St. Louis virtually turned over their city to the Rotarians upon the occasion of the International convention there. A few years ago the Rotarians met with a similar experience at Glasgow, Scotland. Everywhere, Rotary is recognized as one of the most potent influences for good in commercial life.
