

## SAYS TEACHERS NEED OWN HOME

Parent-Teacher Association  
Head Asks Citizens to  
Support Movement

INVITE TO HEARING

Present Conditions Called  
Unsatisfactory

The time has come when it is imperative for Winnetka to provide adequate living quarters for the teachers in our schools. We cannot get and keep teachers unless they are happily housed.

Being a village of homes, it is a serious problem to find any place here for the teachers to live. There are no boarding houses and very few apartments. The number of single rooms available is very limited and rooming and going out to meals does not make an ideal situation.

### Make Annual Appeal

We have over seventy teachers in our schools at present and each fall, the superintendent and the Housing committee of the Parent-Teacher association have to appeal to the people of Winnetka to open their homes and give our teachers a place to live. We now have a proposition from William Aitken to build an apartment house for our teachers. This building is to be located on Gage street, just west of the Aitken block. It will contain a number of small apartments, two rooms, kitchenette and bath, which will be rented to the teachers at a low rent. In that way, we will have a permanent home for about twenty-five teachers.

### Appeals Board Hearing

To secure permission to put up this building, the school board and the Parent-Teacher association have gone before the Village council and presented the need and Mr. Aitken's plan which will meet this splendidly. Recognizing the need, the council referred the matter to the Zoning Board of Appeals, which will have an informal hearing on this subject Monday evening, December 3, at the village hall.

The people of Winnetka can help us by coming to that meeting and supporting this effort to provide a satisfactory place for our teachers to live.

The hour of the performance is 7.30 o'clock, and it is anticipated that a large crowd will be at hand to witness this interesting drama.

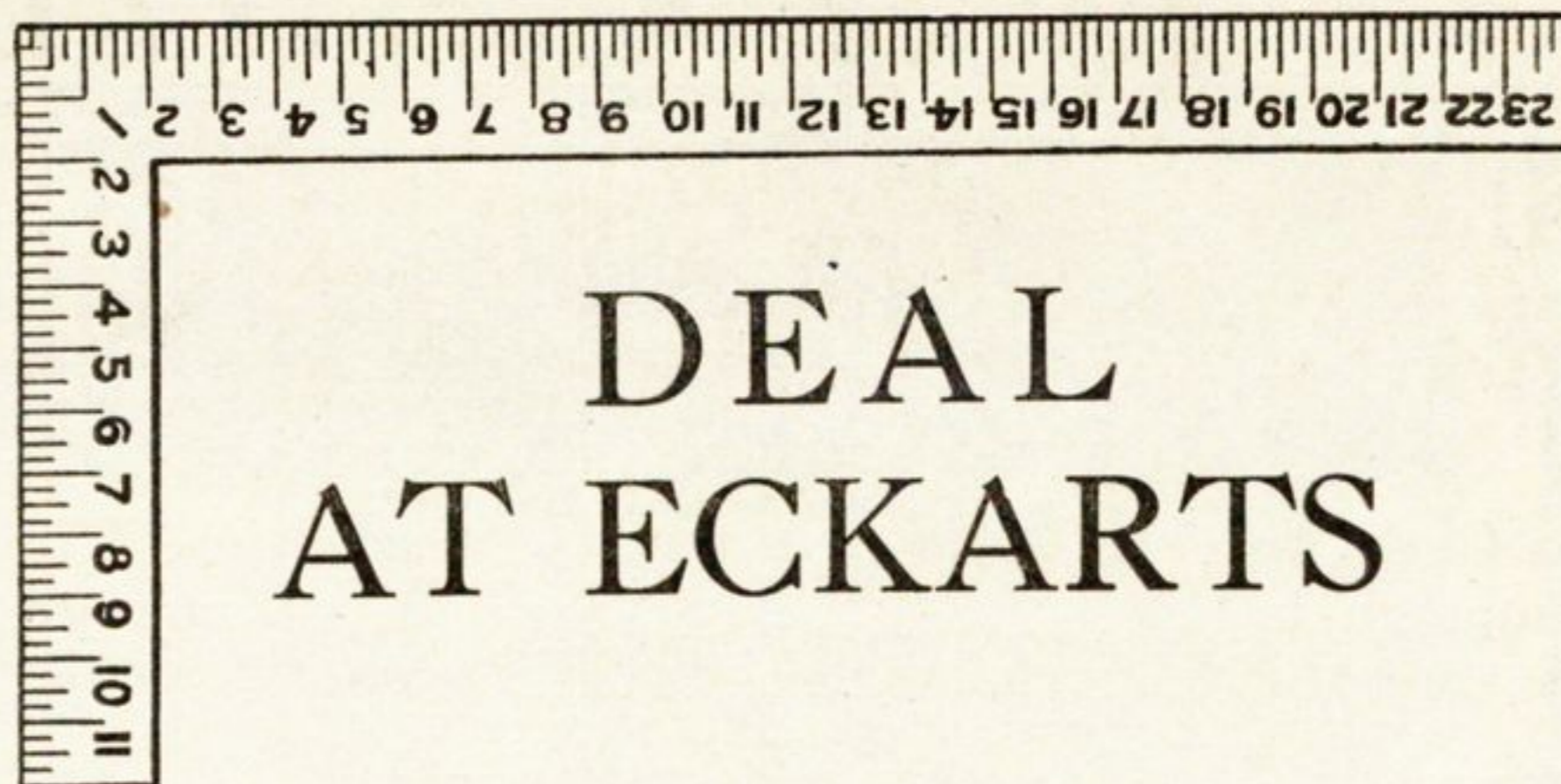

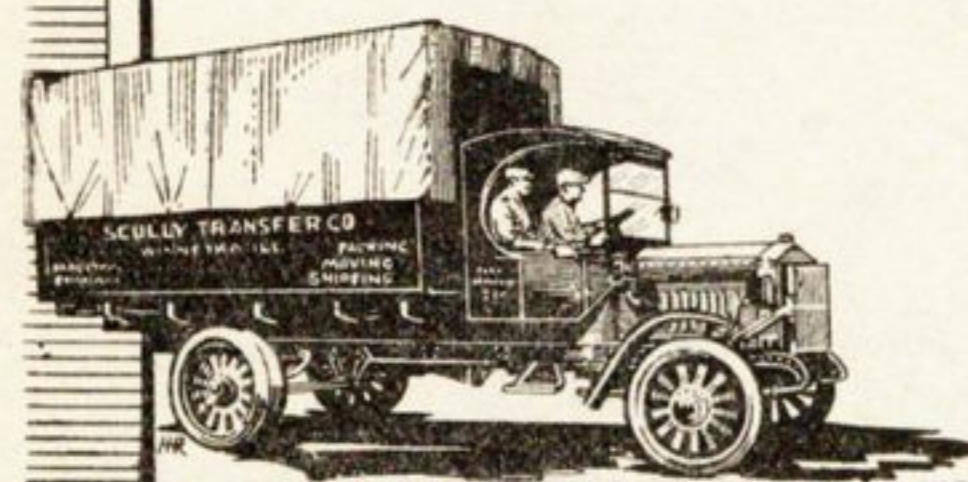
