The Evanston hospital last Saturday cared for 184 patients, the largest number in the history of the institution, according to an announcement by Miss Ada Belle McCleery, superintendent. The large registration at this time of the year is a matter of surprise, as the Christmas season is usually a slack one at hospitals, it is said. Patients who can put off operations not absolutely necessary usually delay them until after the Yuletide festivities, hospital authorities say. The largest previous record of the Evanston hospital was 178 patients registered there last March, which was in the midst of the hospital's busy season and at a time when rush orders abound.
