

1,500 REJOICE AT DEDICATION

Visitors Come from Far and Near for Big Event at St. John's

LAUD CONGREGATION

Wilmette Church Council Praises Work

More than 1,500 people attended the dedication of St. John's Lutheran church at Wilmette and Park avenues Sunday, December 16, when the congregation observed the memorable event at three great services attended by Lutheran people from all sections of Chicago and vicinity.

The principal dedicatory address was given by Rev. Herman W. Meyer, pastor of the church, whose guiding hand and exceptional ability at organization, together with a peculiar faculty for "getting things done," and coupled with the tireless energy of a Building committee, were largely responsible for the establishment of the beautiful new church plant. Rev. Meyer spoke at the morning service of dedication.

In the afternoon and evening there

were other services of dedication and consecration at which leading divines of the Lutheran denomination were the principal speakers. Special soloists and the Lutheran double quartet of the Chicago district provided the programs of music.

Especially gratifying during the dedicatory services was a communication from the Wilmette church council, (comprising the Protestant churches of the village and of which St. John's church is a member,) which tendered its congratulations upon the remarkable achievement of the local parish in securing such a beautiful church home, regarding the dedication as one of the outstanding events in the religious life of the community.

Leading ministers who spoke at the dedicatory services were Rev. F. W. G. Mueller, a former pastor of the local church; Rev. Paul Luecke, Rev. K. G. Schlerf and Rev. F. H. Kretschmar, also a former pastor of the congregation.

Soloists who, with the quartet, gave a brilliant program, included Mrs. T. C. Doering, Mrs. A. J. Brockmann and Orian Galitz.

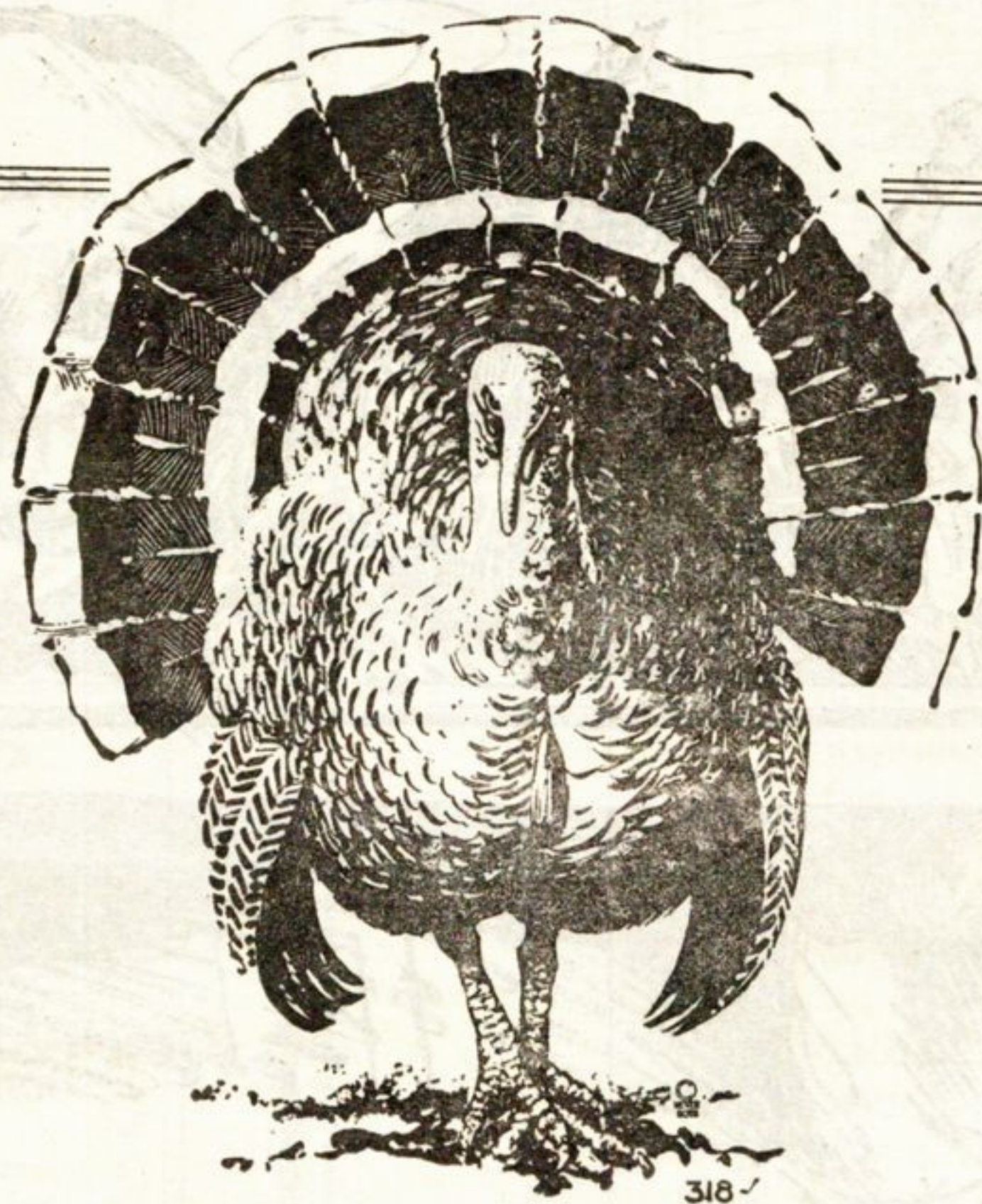
