EXPECT PARLEY ON ROAD PLAN

Evanston Asked to Widen W. Railroad Avenue

Winnetka and Evanston authorities are expected to confer in the very near future in connection with the proposed plan to widen West Railroad avenue in that city to connect with the prospective widened Main street at the south village limits.

The Village board has directed a communication to Mayor Harry P. Pearson of Evanston, setting forth the advisability of having West Railroad avenue included in the widened through thoroughfare which, with the proposed through highway to be located on the west side of the North-western tracks in New Trier Township and the McCormick highway extending along the drainage channel and joining with West Railroad avenue, would provide a great traffic artery into the north side of Chicago.

Action on a matter of having West Railroad avenue widened will be delayed by at least 60 days as explained in Evanston, due to the absence of Mayor Pearson, who is in the south.

As previously announced in Winnetka Life, the widening and repaving of Main street throughout the length of the village will probably go forward early in the summer. Villages to the north have signified their intention of continuing the highway to the north county line.

The board of County commissioners has appropriated \$100,000 as its portion of the expense of the proposed through highway, which would be a county aid road. The separate villages will bear their proportionate share of the cost.

INTEREST HERE IN REALTORS SESSION

North shore realtors are turning their attention at this time to the meeting of the National Association of Real Estate boards to be held in Atlanta, Ga., January 17-19.

Many of the important matters to be discussed at the convention will be Secretary Mellon's tax reduction program, it is said.

National officers making their home in Evanston, who will be at the Atlanta meeting include Herbert U. Nelson, executive secretary of the national association, and Hiram S. Cody, treasurer of the national association.

Regarding the meeting in Atlanta, Mr. Nelson said: "Bringing together representatives from the 495 constituent real estate boards of the United States and Canada and representing in their membership of 20,000 not only real estate owners but the general interests of ownership in real property, the meeting, constituting practically the annual meeting of the organization, will be the principal gathering of real estate men to be held this year for the formulation of real estate policies and action."

South Side sewage treatment works, \$1,500,000; total when complete, \$7,500,000.

Regulating works for Great Lakes, \$2,500,000.

Calumet River dredging, \$500,000; total when complete \$1,500,000.

McCormick Creek extension along Drainage canal to W. Railroad avenue, Evanston, \$800,000.

24,738,758,739 Talks On Phones During 1922

There were 24,738,758,739 telephone calls over America's 14,346,701 telephones during 1922 according to an estimate made by the United States census in a late report. The operations of telephone companies showed \$684,904,736 in revenues which is an increase of 75.8 per cent over 1917.

The value of the plants was estimated at \$2,205,121,610, an increase of 47.8 per cent over 1917. Employees numbered \$553,263,801, an increase of 101.1 per cent.

There were 57,248 systems or lines and 37,265,528 miles of wire connected to 14,346,701 telephones.
