The Horace Mann school has inaugurated daily Assemblies to meet from 11:25 to 11:45 every school day except Tuesday.

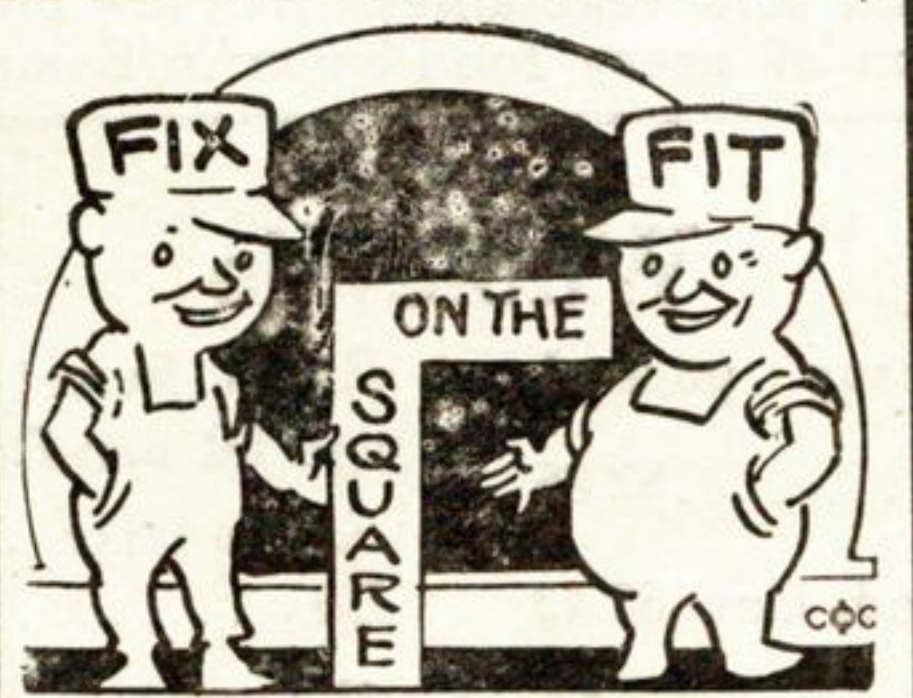
It is planned to have outside talent provide the program at the Monday assembly and parents of school children will be asked to offer their services in co-operating on that day.
