Need Executives for Veterans' Hospitals

Following an entirely new policy, the United States Veterans' bureau will appoint, as soon as they are available, business executives for approximately 50 veterans' hospitals, it is stated in an announcement by the United States civil service commission sent out from the local postoffice this week.

The commission will receive applications for positions of business executive until May 20. The salaries range from \$3,000 to \$5,000 a year, it is announced.

The business executive at a hospital will serve under the general direction of the medical officer in charge, and will relieve him of all details of business management.

Applicants will be rated on their training, experience and fitness, weighted at 80 per cent, and a discussion and plan of organization, weighted at 20 per cent.

Full information and application blanks may be secured from the

United States Civil Service Commission, Washington, D. C., or the secretary of the local board of civil-service examiners at the postoffice, it is explained.

The program of music at the morning services will include the following numbers by the church soloists:

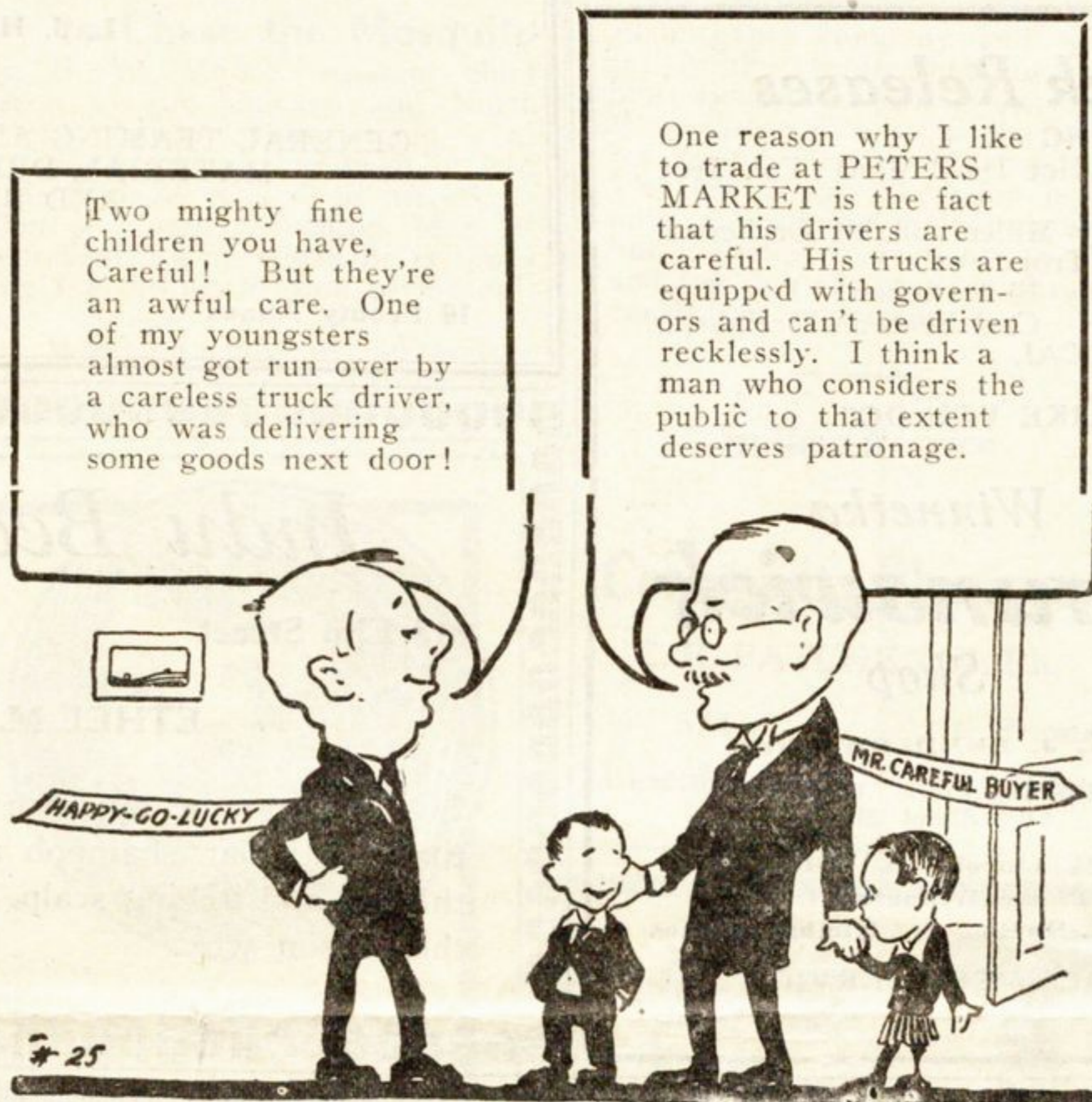

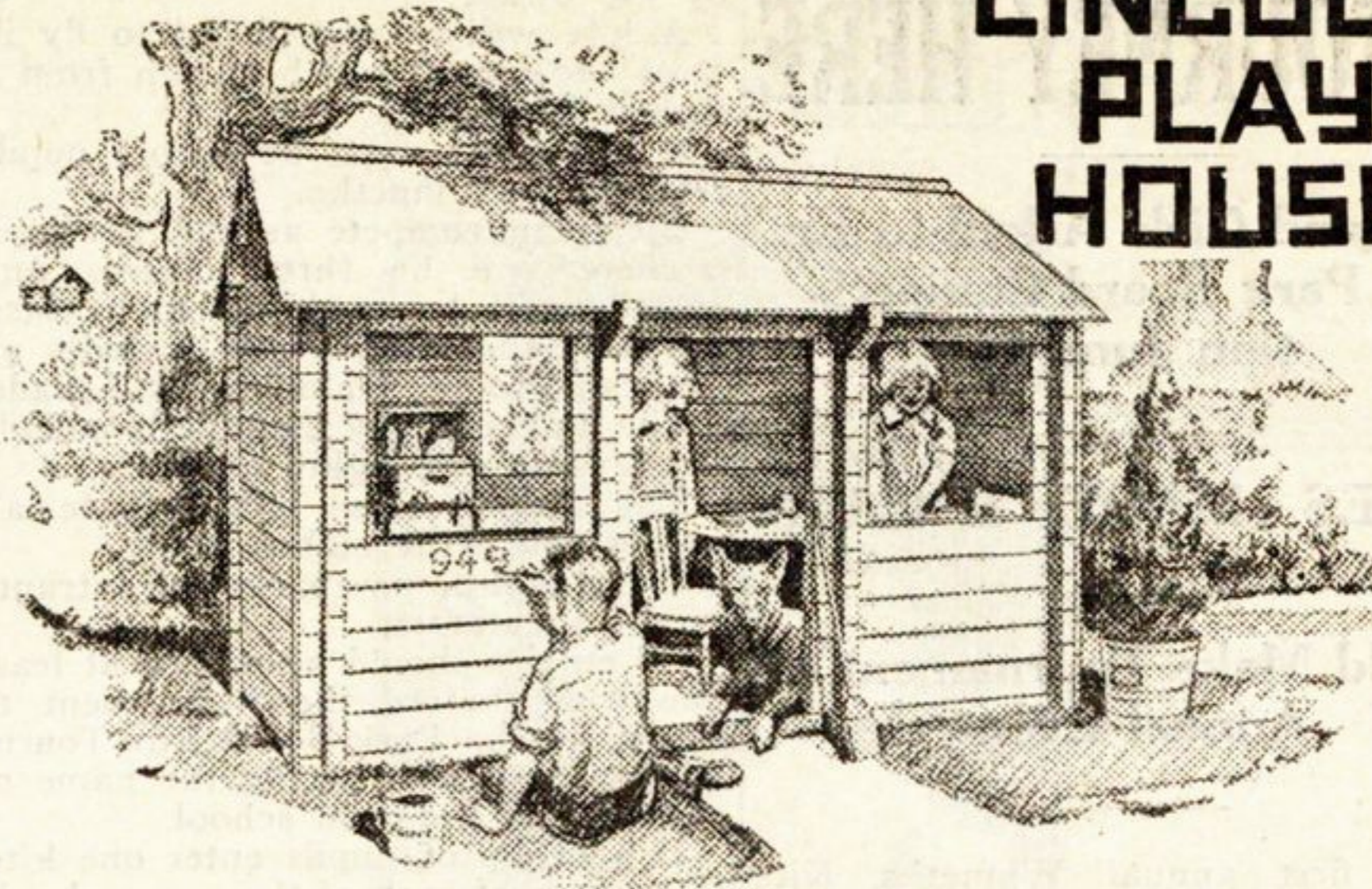
