

**C. C. HOSMER DIRECTS ARCHITECTURE EXHIBIT**

Clare C. Hosmer, of 1232 Forest avenue, Wilmette, and a member of the American Institute of Architects, is director of the Chicago Architectural Exhibition league, an organization whose 1924 Year Book has just been published. This league, according to its published statement, is a corporation whose purpose it is to take over the functions of a joint committee of architects which hitherto has given the annual Architectural exhibition. Hereafter this exhibition will be in the hands of the Exhibition league.

The league believes that a permanent body can plan its program for a number of years and with the accumulated experience and good will can produce exhibitions that will reflect credit on the profession.

This year's is the 37th annual exhibition and will be on display for the entire month of May in the east galleries of the Chicago Art Institute. The aforementioned year book is a catalogue of the exhibit. This book is a sumptuous volume of several hundred pages filled with remarkably attractive pictures of residences, many of them on the north shore, public and commercial buildings, and finally ecclesiastical and educational structures, including the new Ridge school in Wilmette.

Among the architects, pictures of whose productions appear prominently in the book, are George W. Maher, mere mention of whose name is almost sufficient, because virtually every north shore resident knows of his artistic work, in Kenilworth especially. His other architectural achievements might also be described more in detail did not lack of space forbid. His latest undertaking is the planning of the Woman's Library club building in Glencoe.

Other north shore architects mentioned in this year book are Alfred Alschuler, E. C. Clark, and J. L. Hamilton.

One of the most interesting pictures

in the book is the perspective drawing of the school to be built on Ridge avenue in Wilmette. Besides this there are many illustrations of homes in Glencoe, Winnetka, and Kenilworth.
