The Community Nursery school, lo-Woods, gave an exhibition of its pupils' work on Sunday, June 1. This exhibition showed the results of the children's work in nature study, geography, handcrafts, arithmetic and carpentry. This school was established three years ago by Carmelita Hinton and Corinne Fitzpatrick, the latter having been for the past year director in charge of the school. The aim of the school is to take the young child into a small group meeting in a home and there give him an opportunity to work and play in a social way with the materials and tools suited to his age. The principles of the school are drawn almost entirely from the philosophy of John Dewey, one of the world's foremost authorities in pedagogy.


