Frank E. Goodnow Named By Mayor Dever

Frank E. Goodnow, electrical engineer of the Public Service Company of Northern Illinois, will represent the public on the Mayor's Radio Commission of Chicago. He has just been appointed by Mayor Dever, who selected

him on recommendation of the Western Society of Engineers.

Other members of the commission, the announced purpose of which will be to harmonize all radio activities in Chicago and nearby territory, will represent broadcasting stations and manufacturers and dealers in radio equipment.

Mr. Goodnow, whose personal hobby for the last fifteen years has been radio, recently returned from abroad where he combined a study of electrical development, in the interests of his company, with that of radio progress throughout the nations of Europe.

His prominence in the amateur radio field, together with his contact with

the public both of Chicago and throughout the territory served by the Public Service Company of Northern Illinois, made Mr. Goodnow the choice of the Western Society of Engineers when Mayor Dever asked the advice of that organization in making his appointment to the commission.

lage engineer, has been assisting the board in working out the problem. The most feasible suggestion that has been made, and it is one that is being very seriously considered, is the idea of constructing a low dirt dike along the western line of the golf course, starting at North avenue on the north and extending south so as to hold the water back from the golf course. It will be impossible to take levels and get any definite figures on this project until somewhat later in the summer when the ground is dryer. "Another factor that enters into the question is the fact that there is a movement to acquire more land for park purposes in that neighborhood, and the exact location of such a dike cannot be determined until it is known exactly what land is to be included back of it. Taking into consideration all of the angles of the situation, it is confidently believed that a solution will be worked out which will be a satisfactory one and which will insure maximum amount of play on the

golf course with a minimum amount of inconvenience.

"So far as this year is concerned, judging from the present weather, there is a strong probability that there will be at least three months of good golf playing on the course this season. Such funds as the Winnetka Park district has taken in for golf fees have been and will be much needed to meet the very unusual conditions this year, and to keep the course going as a nucleus for the very much improved course which it is hoped to develop during the next few years as the plans of the board for the future are put into effect."

Small Girls Injured in Boulevard Auto Crash

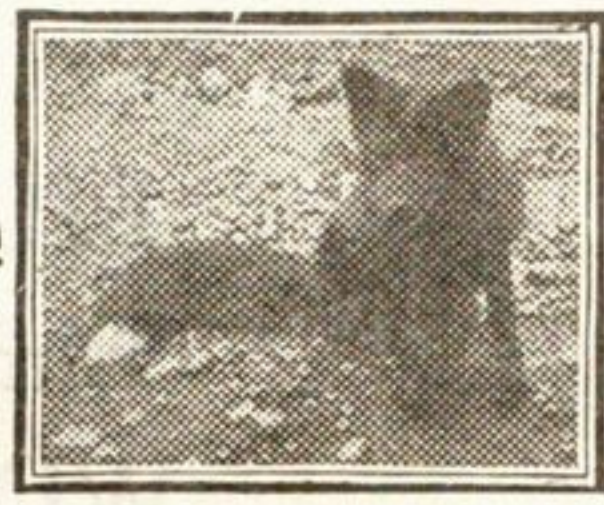

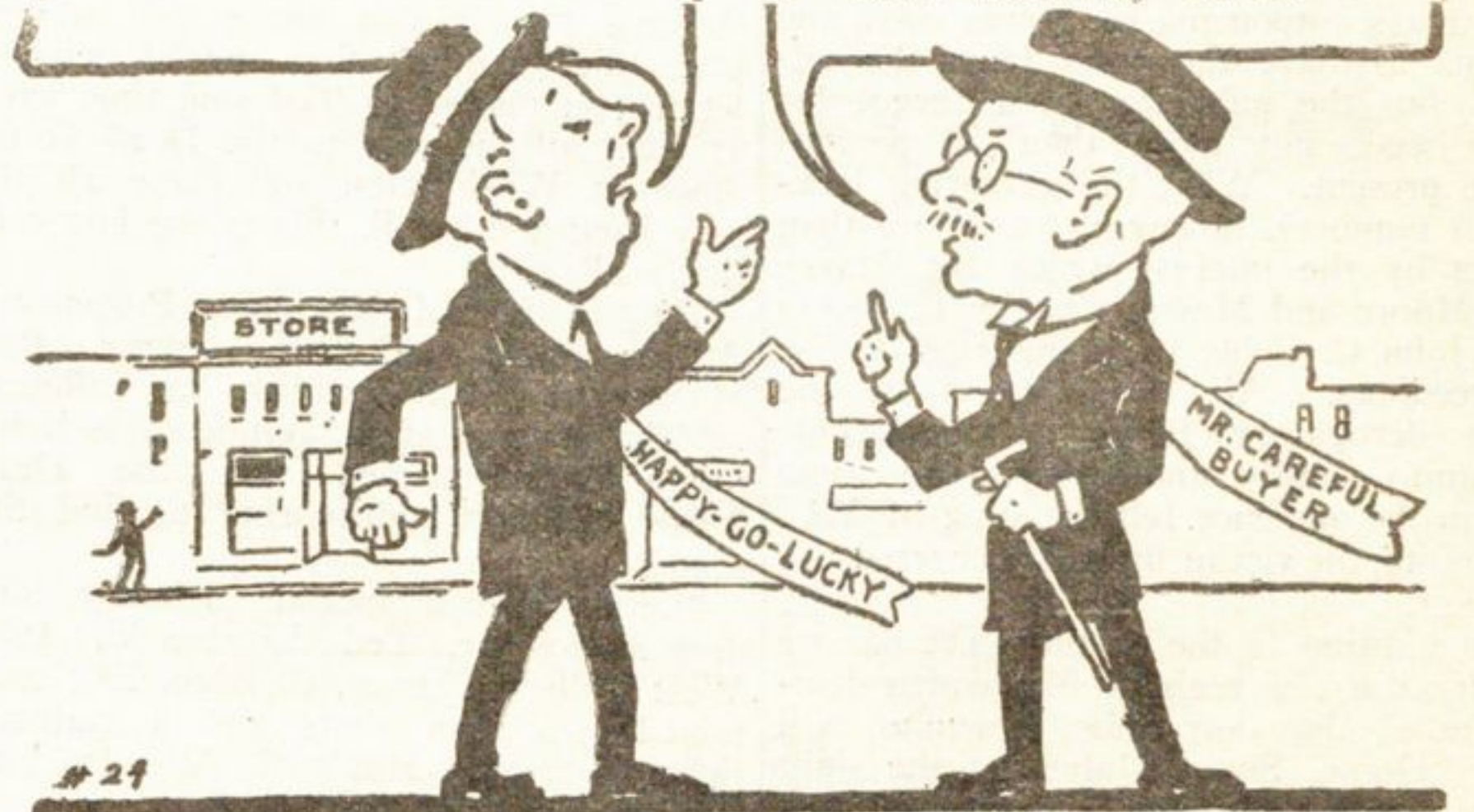
