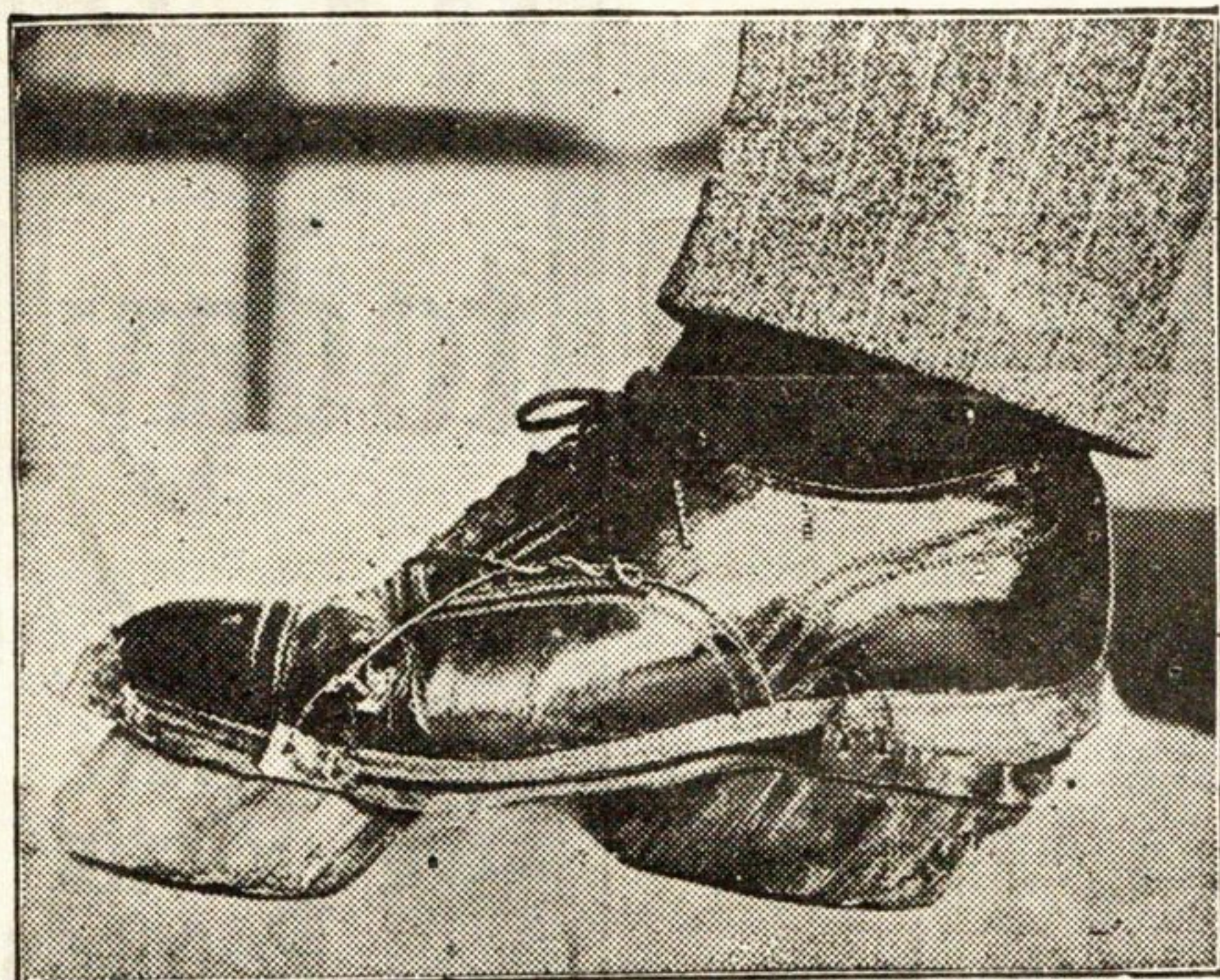


**"Cow Footprints" to Fool Dry Agents**

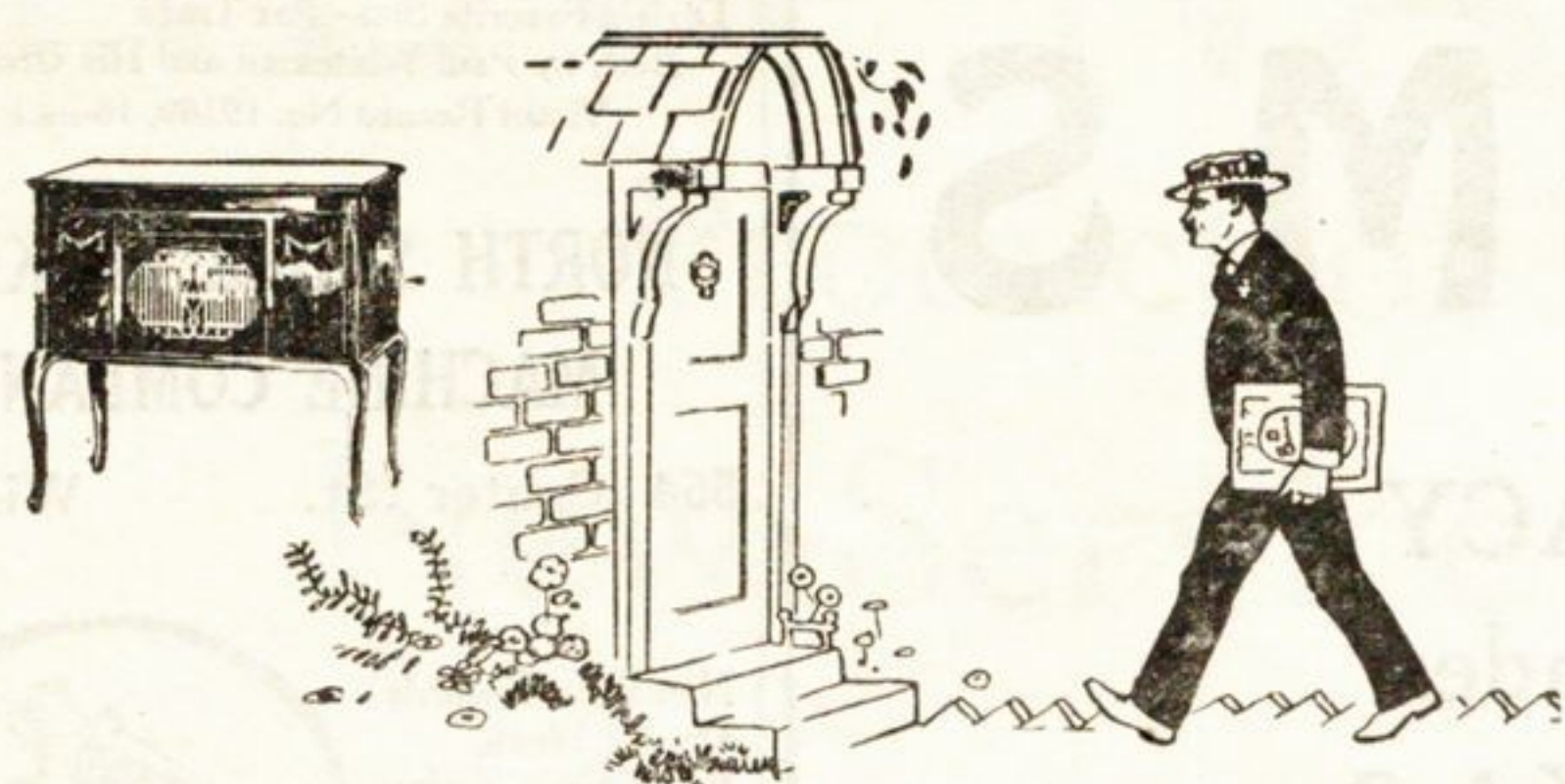

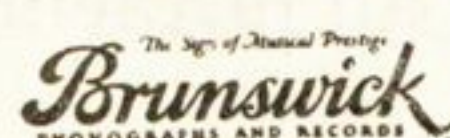
