

**ORRINGTON ANNEX IS OPENED FOR OCCUPANCY**

Completed on schedule time, the luxurious 63-apartment Orrington hotel annex at Evanston was formally opened Monday of this week with all apartments, save seven, leased for immediate occupancy. A majority of these apartments have been rented to north shore people, the hotel management stated.

Construction on the Orrington Annex was started on April 12, 1924, under the direction of Victor C. Carlson, owner and builder of the Orrington and Library Plaza hotels. The structure represents an investment of approximately \$750,000.

The Annex is unique in that the apartments are rented unfurnished but with complete hotel service. Everything supplied in the best appointed hotels is at the command of the Annex residents.

Included among the features of the Annex is a bungalow playroom, with outdoor pergola, and an open air veranda 50 by 16 feet in dimensions.

The building contains 30 maid's rooms for families having private maid service. There is also a 36-car garage in direct connection with the building.

The Annex contains seven new shops on its Orrington avenue frontage, three of which are already rented. Among the concerns to be located there is the well known Cellini Jewelry and Gift shop. The MacLean Beauty parlor will also be located in the building.

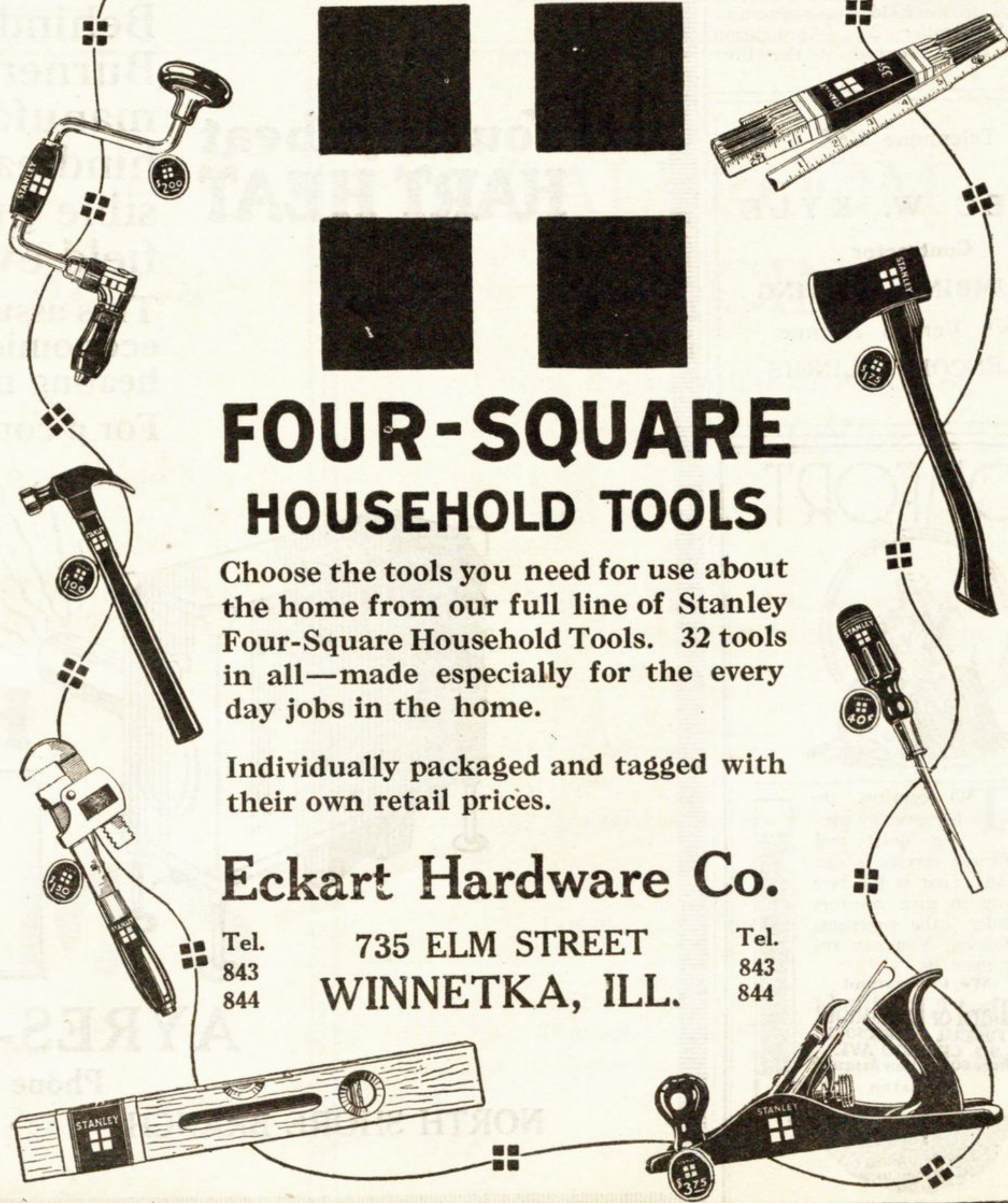
