

Figures recently compiled by 93 per cent of its automobile wrecks are caused by carelessness. Of 9,131 accidents reportto carelessness. Added to these may be included the following: speeding, 183; failure to give months. Why not you? right of way, 1381; reckless driving while intoxicated, 123; failure to give signal, 290; driving on left side of street or highway, 64; improper parking, 79; reverse direction in middle of block, 40: passing to left of street cars while discharging passengers, 31; inexperience, 24; jockeying on bridges, 21; a total of 8480 accidents which might have been avoided, according to the report of the secretary of state, had the drivers been careful.
