

ASK CITIZENRY TO CURB FIRES

Fire Prevention Week, October 5-11, Educates to Prevent Fire Losses

OBSERVED IN VILLAGE

Chief Houren Requests the Schools to Co-operate

Circular letters, posters and talks to children in the schools will be the means of arresting the attention of Winnetka residents upon Fire Prevention Week, October 5-11, according to Chief G. M. Houren of the village fire department.

The letters will be sent to every home in the village so that every one will know of the fire prevention campaign. Posters showing the danger of fires in communities will be placed in prominent places in the village and will be shown to the children in the schools.

Talks to Children

Chief Houren has requested that the teachers in the various schools devote a brief period during the fire prevention week to make suggestions on avoiding and preventing fires.

In connection with Fire Prevention Week, Chief Houren has issued a set of rules for the storage of fuel oil. These are in conformity with the regulations established by the National Underwriters association. Where the oil tanks are in the basement of a house, the insurance rates are much higher than where the tanks are located outside.

The rules for the storage of fuel oil as given out by Chief Houren for Winnetka are:

Rules for Oil Storage

Open storage tanks in basements shall not exceed 275 gallons capacity, with not more than 60 gallons under gravity feed.

Inside tanks up to 1,500 gallons capacity are allowed in basements provided equivalent to twelve inches of reining they are enclosed with an insulation

forced concrete with at least a six-inch space on sides between tank and concrete, filled with sand or well tamped earth, with twelve inches of sand on top of tank either between tank and concrete or above concrete slab.

Tanks up to 2,500 gallons capacity are allowed underground in basements.

Tanks above ground outside of buildings may have a capacity of 1,000 gallons or less if located ten feet from the nearest building, and up to 3,000 gallons if located twenty feet from the nearest building.

Underground tanks outside of buildings, if located ten feet from the nearest building, may have a capacity up to 25,000 gallons.

In all cases provision must be made to prevent siphoning inside basements.

Colorful posters, depicting the tragic results of fire damage have been distributed by the Department of Trade and Commerce, Division of Fire Prevention, under supervision of John G. Gamber, Illinois fire marshal. Among other precautionary material, these posters contain the following pertinent queries for the householder:

Is your heating equipment safe?

Is your chimney defective?

Is your electric wiring dangerous?

Do you keep rubbish cleaned up?

Are you careful with gasoline?

Are you careful with matches and smoking materials?

"Make Sure! Play Safe! A careful person seldom has a fire. Be careful!" is the concluding note of warning.

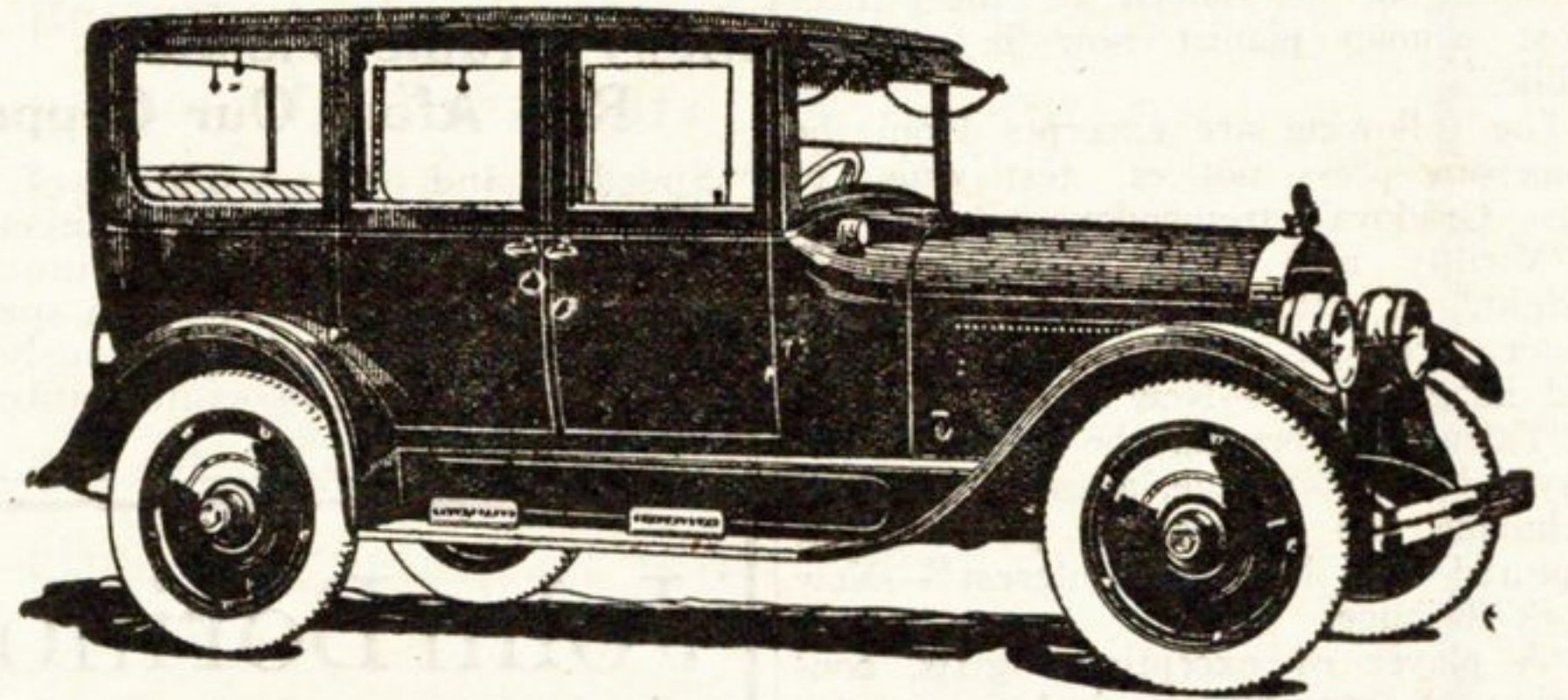

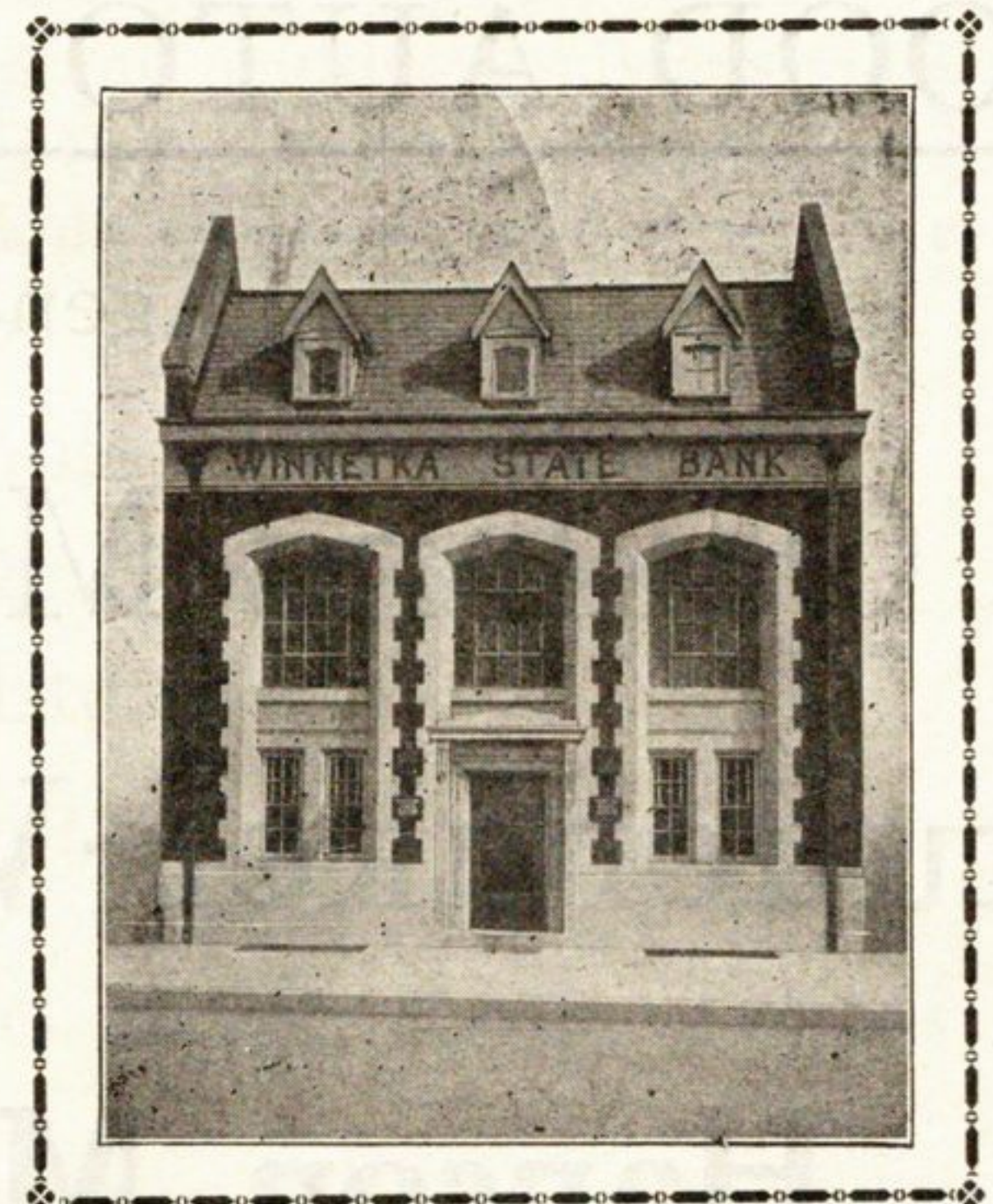

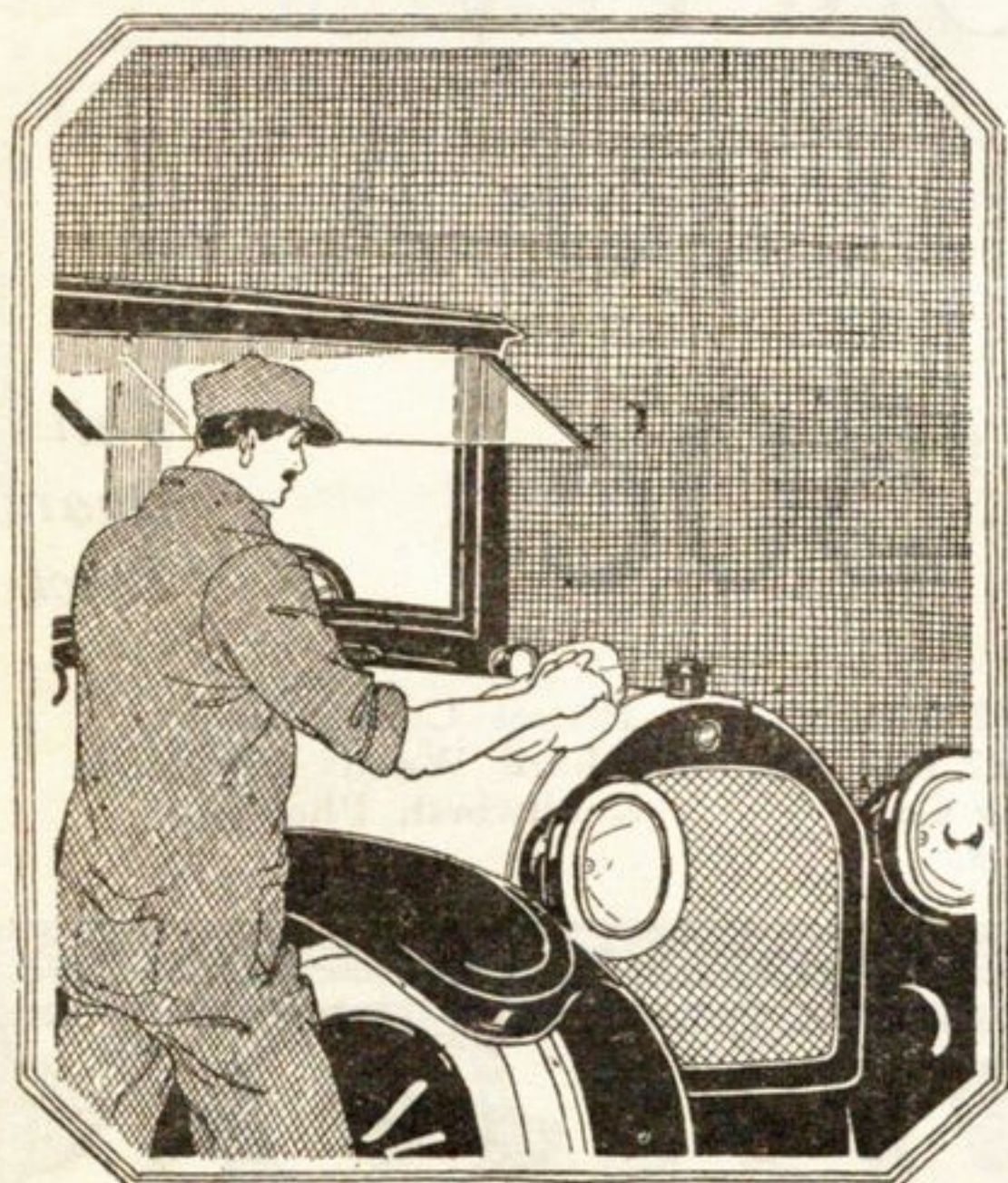
