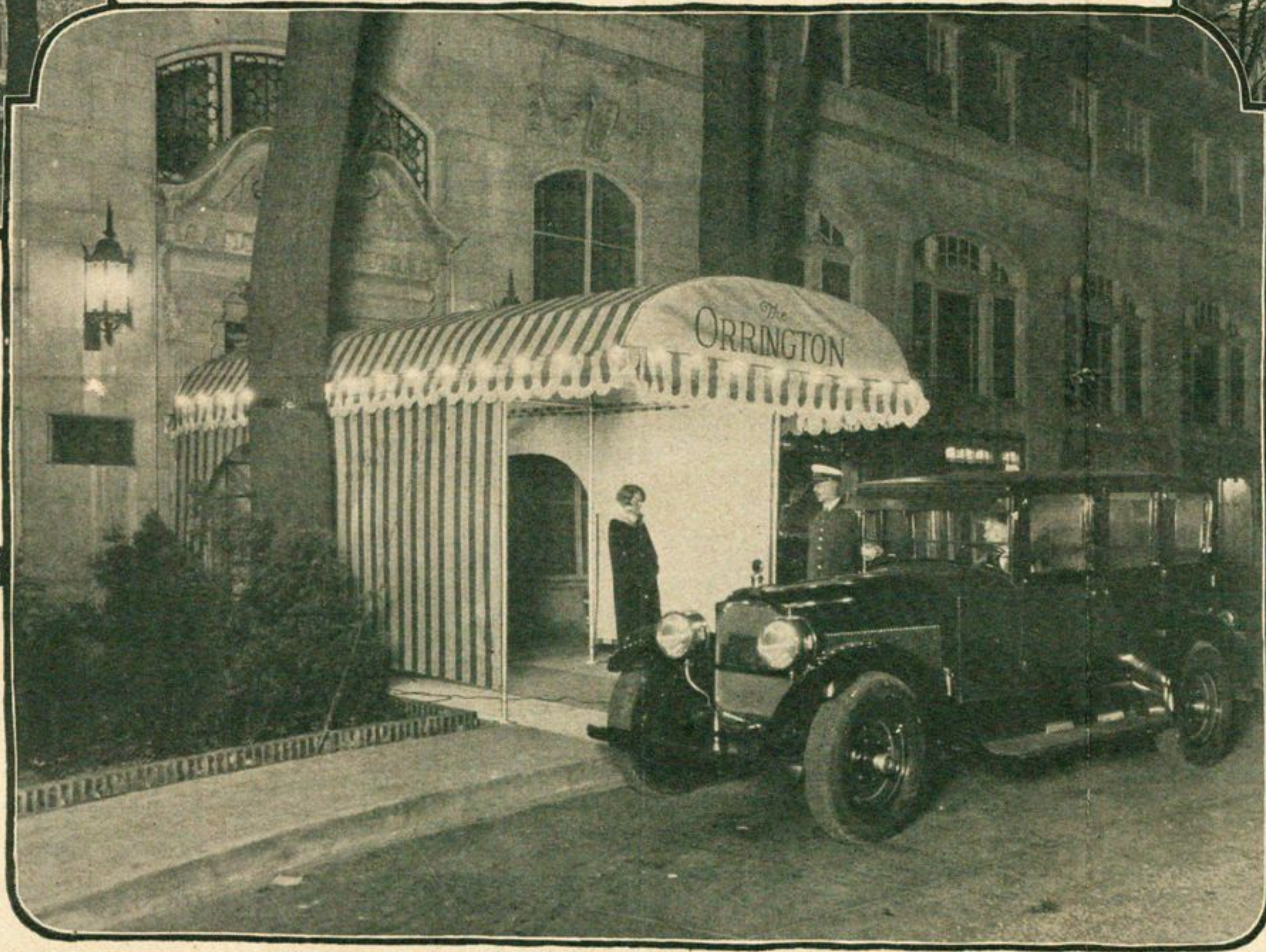

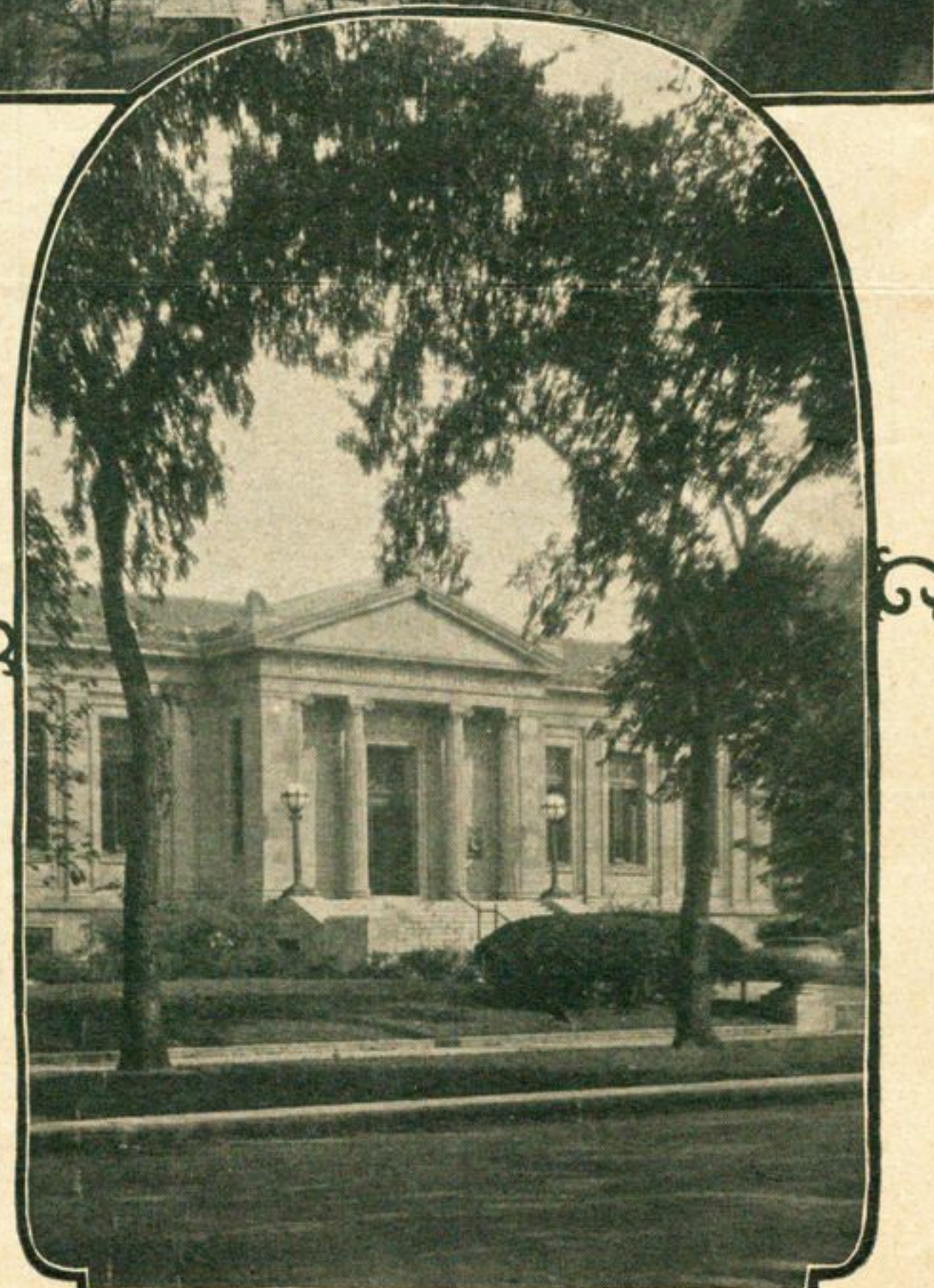
THE ORRINGTON—Evanston's largest and finest apartment hotel. A beautiful building of Indiana lime stone and mottled red brick, representing an investment of \$3,000,000.00. The location is ideal—close to transportation, Northwestern University, schools, churches, stores, clubs and the lake. Stately elms surround the entire structure. The original building was completed September 1st, 1924. Eight months later work was begun, and is now finished, on a large addition necessary to accommodate the patronage. The quarters consist of beautifully furnished single rooms and suites with and without kitchenettes, and unfurnished kitchenette apartments of two to eight rooms with hotel service. Maids' rooms and garages in direct connection are features. To the right is The Orrington in course of construction. It is modern in every detail, and fireproof!
