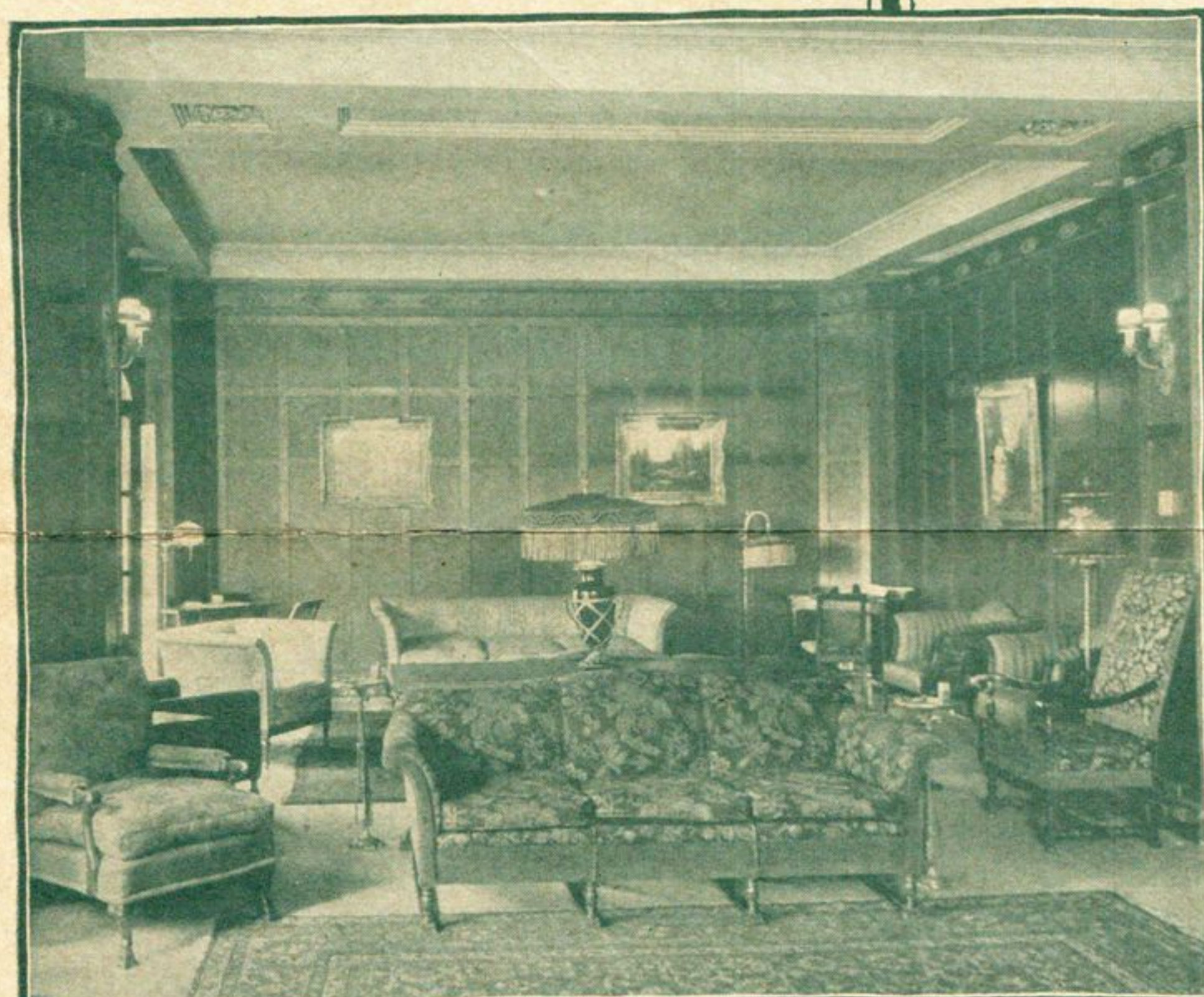

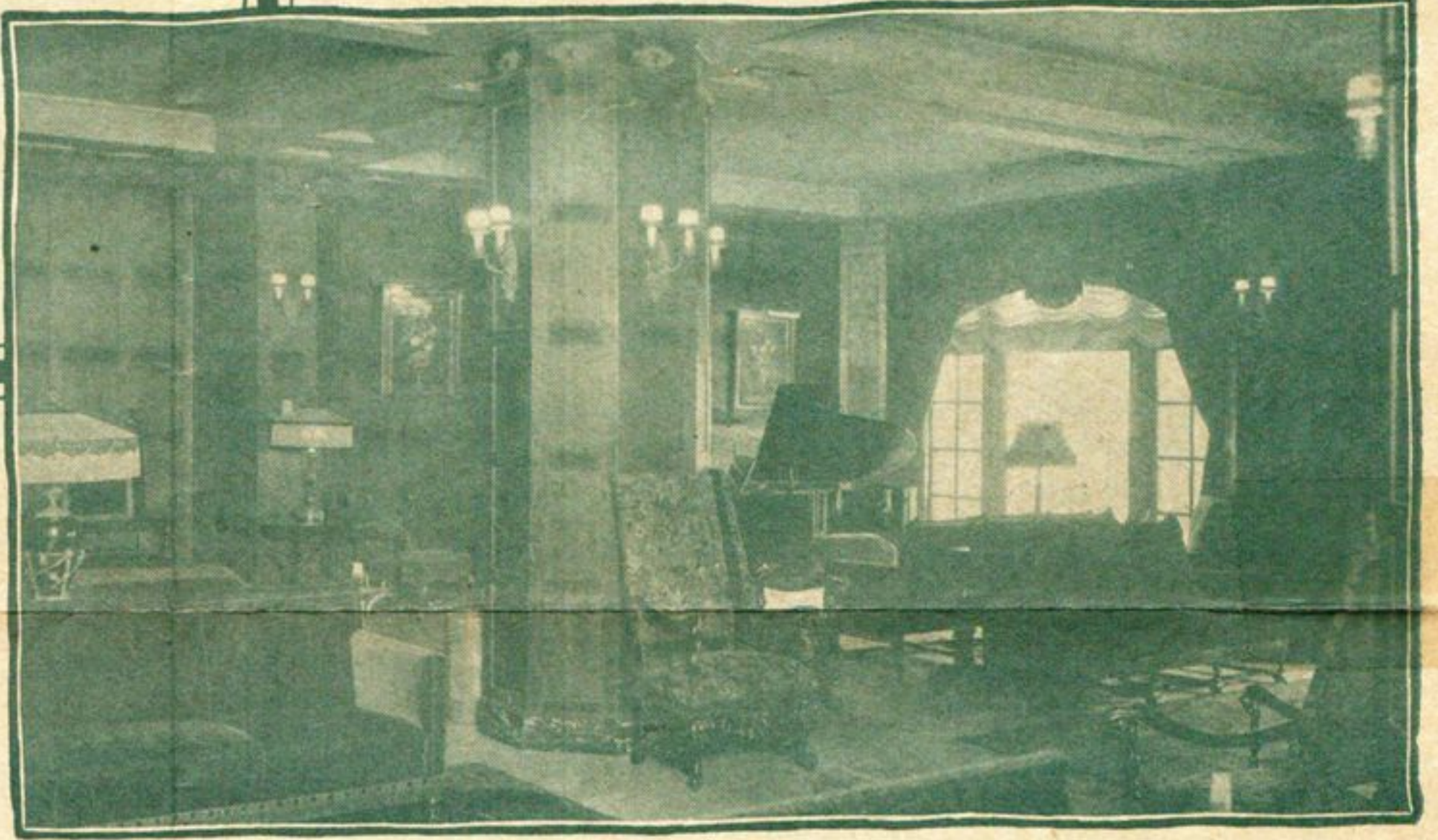
THE ELEVATOR LOBBY. Three high-speed elevators provide speedy transportation to your floor. The coffered ceiling is a symphony of beautiful coloring



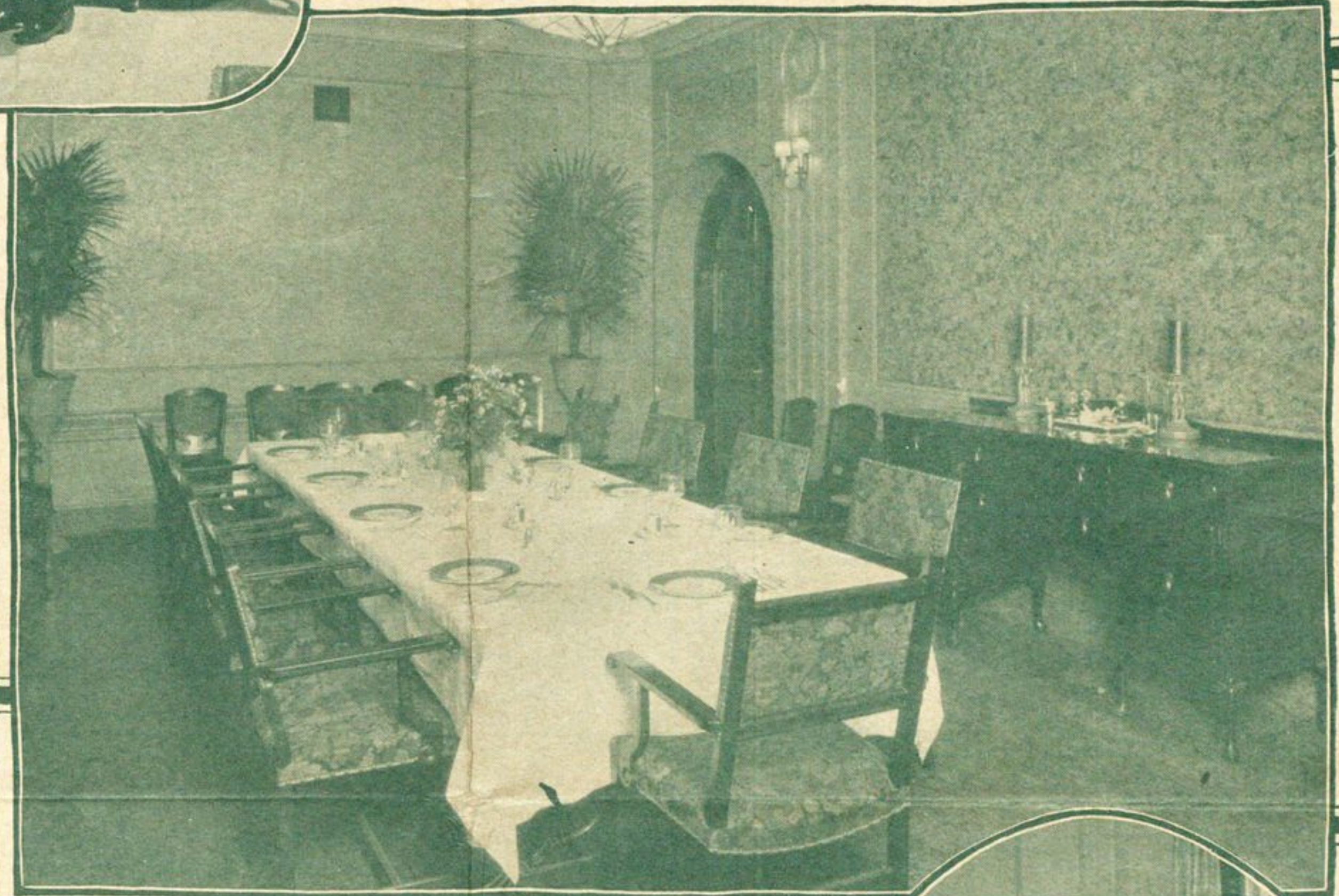
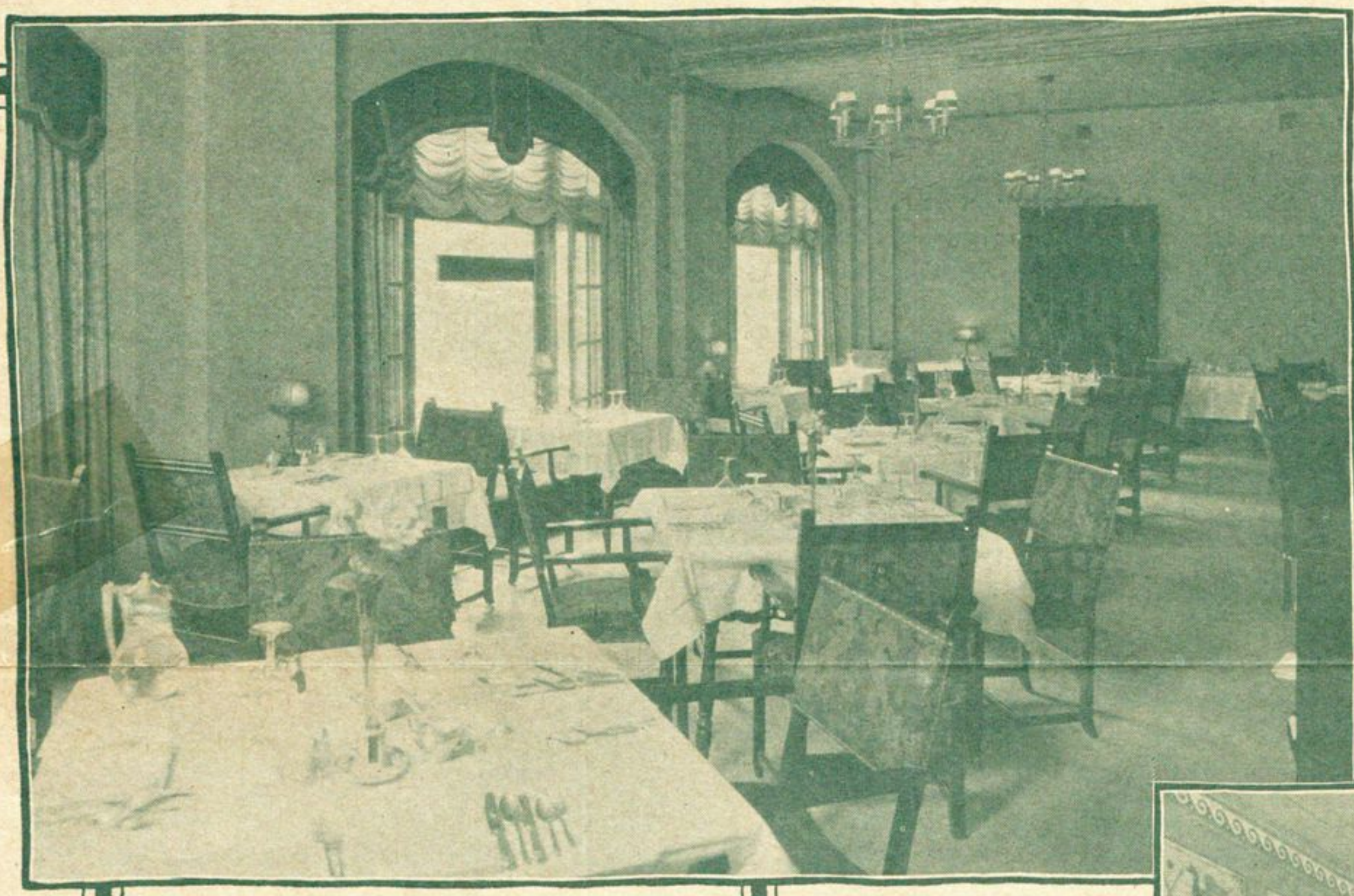

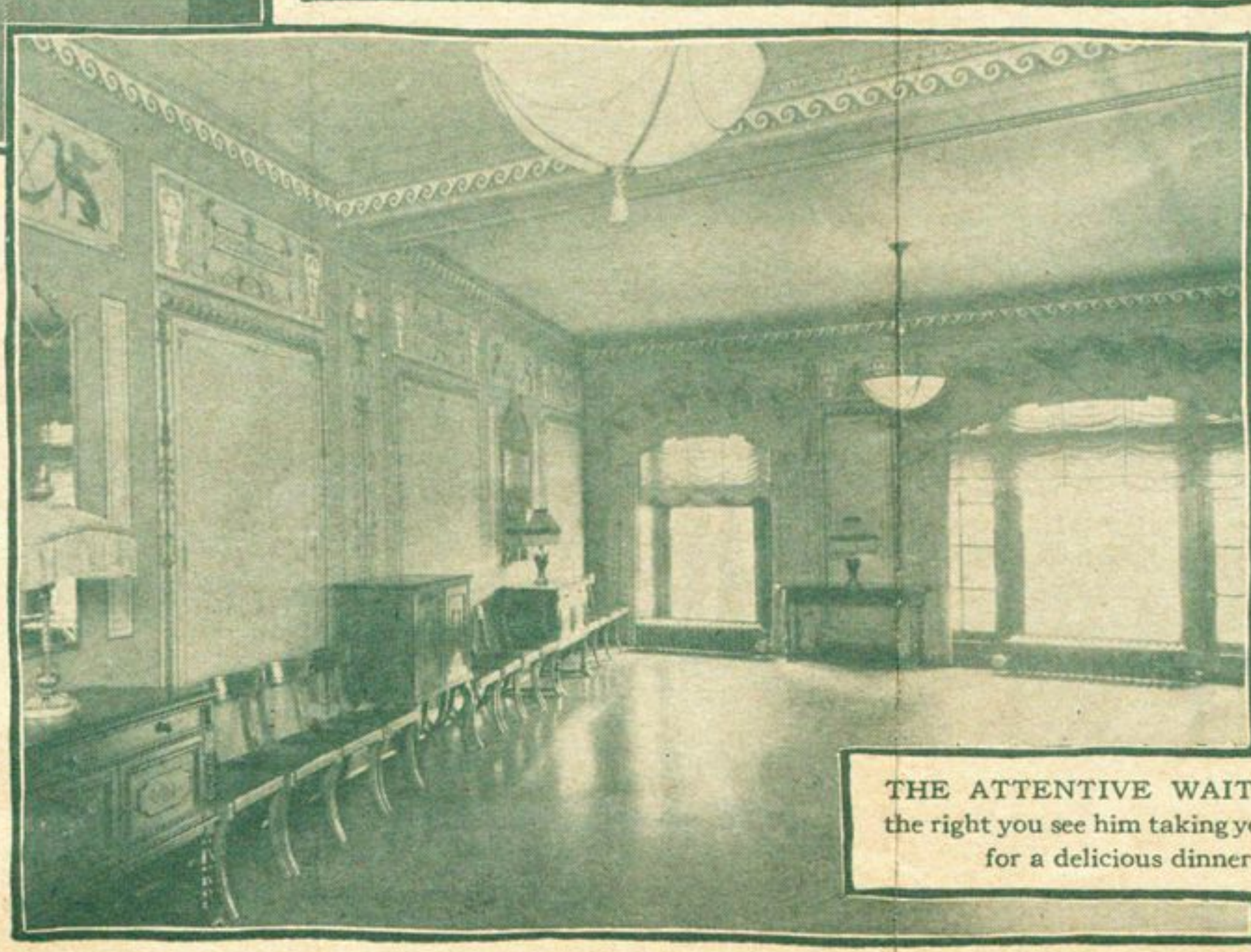
THE PARLOR MAID—Busy always with her dusting and ever willing to do a favor
