

'MERTON' NEXT FILM FEATURE

Glenn Hunter at Community House Tuesday

"Merton of the Movies," the deliciously satirical comedy-drama of Hollywood's movieland, is to be the feature picture at Community House Tuesday, November 25.

James Cruze, the man who made "The Covered Wagon" and other notable recent Paramount successes, directed "Merton." It is a story of a movie-struck country youth who goes penniless to Hollywood, meets adversity and indifference, but eventually wins stardom through the guidance of a picture-wise girl.
