NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT sealed bids for the construction of a local improvement to be made in Linden Avenue from the north corporate limits of the Village of Winnetka, southerly in said Linden Avenue to the north line extended from the west of North Avenue; in North Avenue from the westerly line extended of the right-of-way of the Chicago and North Western Railway Company west in said North Avenue to a line eighty-four (84) feet west of and parallel with the west line Avenue; in Gage Street from the westerly line extended of the right-of-way of the Chicago and North Western Railway Company southwesterly in said Gage Street to the improvement herein proposed in Linden Avenue; also from the improvement herein proposed in Linden Avenue southwesterly in said Gage Street to a line two hundred fifty (250) feet westerly from and parallel with the westerly line extended of said Linden Avenue; in Scott Avenue from and connecting with the present concrete pavement at a line eighty (80) feet easterly from and parallel with the easterly line extended of Linden Avenue and from the north corporate limits of the Village of Winnetka, southwesterly in said Scott Avenue to the improvement herein proposed in said Linden Avenue; also from the improvement herein proposed in said Scott Avenue to a line twelve (12) feet westerly from and parallel with the westerly line extended of said Linden Avenue; including the south street return at the intersection of North Avenue and Linden Avenue, from the said proposed improvement in North Avenue south in said Linden Avenue to a line twenty-three (23) feet south of and parallel with the south line extended of North Avenue; also the north street return at the intersection of North Avenue and Linden Avenue from the proposed improvement in said Linden Avenue at the north line extended of said North Avenue, southwesterly in North Avenue to and connecting with the said proposed improvement in said North Avenue; also the south street return at North Avenue and Center Street from the proposed improvement in North Avenue southeasterly in said Center Street to a line drawn at right angles to the westerly line of said Center Street from a point in the westerly line of said Center Street fifty (50) feet southwesterly, as measured along the westerly line of said Center Street from the intersection of the south line of said North Avenue with the westerly line of said Center Street and, also, easterly and westerly street returns at the intersection of Linden Avenue and Merrill Street from the proposed improvement in Linden Avenue to a line twelve (12) feet easterly and westerly, respectively, from the easterly and westerly lines extended of said Linden Avenue, by excavating, grubbing, grading, draining, curbing, rubbing, old pavements and combined curbs and gutters, moving and resetting electric light poles, moving and resetting manhole hydrants, adjusting present manhole approaches, adjusting present pavement connections, filling abandoned catchbasins and inlets, constructing new catchbasins with connections to the present storm sewers, preparing the subgrade and paving with reinforced Portland cement concrete a roadway forty (40) feet in width in Linden Avenue from the north corporate limits of the Village of Winnetka to the north line extended from the west of North Avenue; a roadway forty (40) feet in width in Gage Street from the westerly line extended of the right-of-way of the Chicago and North Western Railway Company to the proposed

pavement in Linden Avenue; a roadway forty (40) feet in width from the proposed pavement in Linden Avenue southwesterly in said Gage Street to a line one hundred fifty (150) feet westerly from and parallel with the westerly line extended of said Linden Avenue, from thence said roadway shall gradually diminish to the width of the present pavement in said Gage Street at a line two hundred fifty (250) feet westerly from and parallel with the westerly line extended of said Linden Avenue; a roadway fifty-four (54) feet in width in that portion of North Avenue which is now eighty (80) feet in width from street line to street line, from the westerly line extended of the right-of-way of the Chicago and North Western Railway Company to the easterly line extended from the north of the proposed roadway in said Linden Avenue; the width of the proposed roadway in North Avenue west of the easterly line extended from the north of the proposed roadway in said Linden Avenue shall coincide with the lines of the present pavement in said North Avenue. The width of the proposed roadway in Scott Avenue shall be twenty-six (26) feet at a line eighty (80) feet easterly from and parallel with the easterly line extended of Linden Avenue and from the north corporate limits of the Village of Winnetka to the proposed roadway in said Linden Avenue. The width of the roadway return at Center Street and North Avenue shall be forty (40) feet. The width of the roadway returns at Linden Avenue south and at the west end of said improvement in North Avenue and at the west and east roadway returns at Linden Avenue and Merrill Street shall be twenty-one (21) feet. The width of the roadway at the west return of Linden Avenue and Scott Avenue shall be thirty-two (32) feet. All the roadways shall be widened along curved lines at the curb corners as follows: The radii at the southeast and the southwest curb corners at North Avenue and Center Street shall be twenty (20) feet; at the southeast and southwest curb corners at North Avenue and Linden Avenue thirty-seven (37) feet; at the northeast curb corner of North Avenue and Linden Avenue ninety (90) feet; at the northwest curb corner of North Avenue and Linden Avenue twenty-five (25) feet. At each of the curb corners at Gage Street and Linden Avenue, and at Scott Avenue and Linden Avenue, the radii shall be twenty-five feet, including said proposed concrete pavements, grading, and smoothing parkways, trenching, backfilling and the removal of all surplus excavated materials, all within the Village of Winnetka, County of Cook and State of Illinois, said improvement being otherwise known as Winnetka Special Assessment No. 406,691, in accordance with the ordinance heretofore passed therefor, will be received by the Village of Winnetka by or before eight o'clock p. m. on Tuesday, the ninth day of December, A. Contractors will be paid in bonds bearing interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum for all estimates approved by the Board of Local Improvements, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and over when the amount of balance due on any estimate is less than the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), the same will be paid by bond for amounts in addition to the usual bond for construction and maintenance in the sum equal to the amount of the bid accepted by the Board of Local Improvements, the successful bidder will be required to furnish an indemnity and defense policy in some reliable company, indemnifying the Village of Winnetka against loss from liability for damages on account of the performance of the work required to be performed by the said contractor, by any person or persons, including such liability imposed under the employers' liability and workmen's compensation law of the State of Illinois, and the amendments thereof, in the sum of Five thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).
