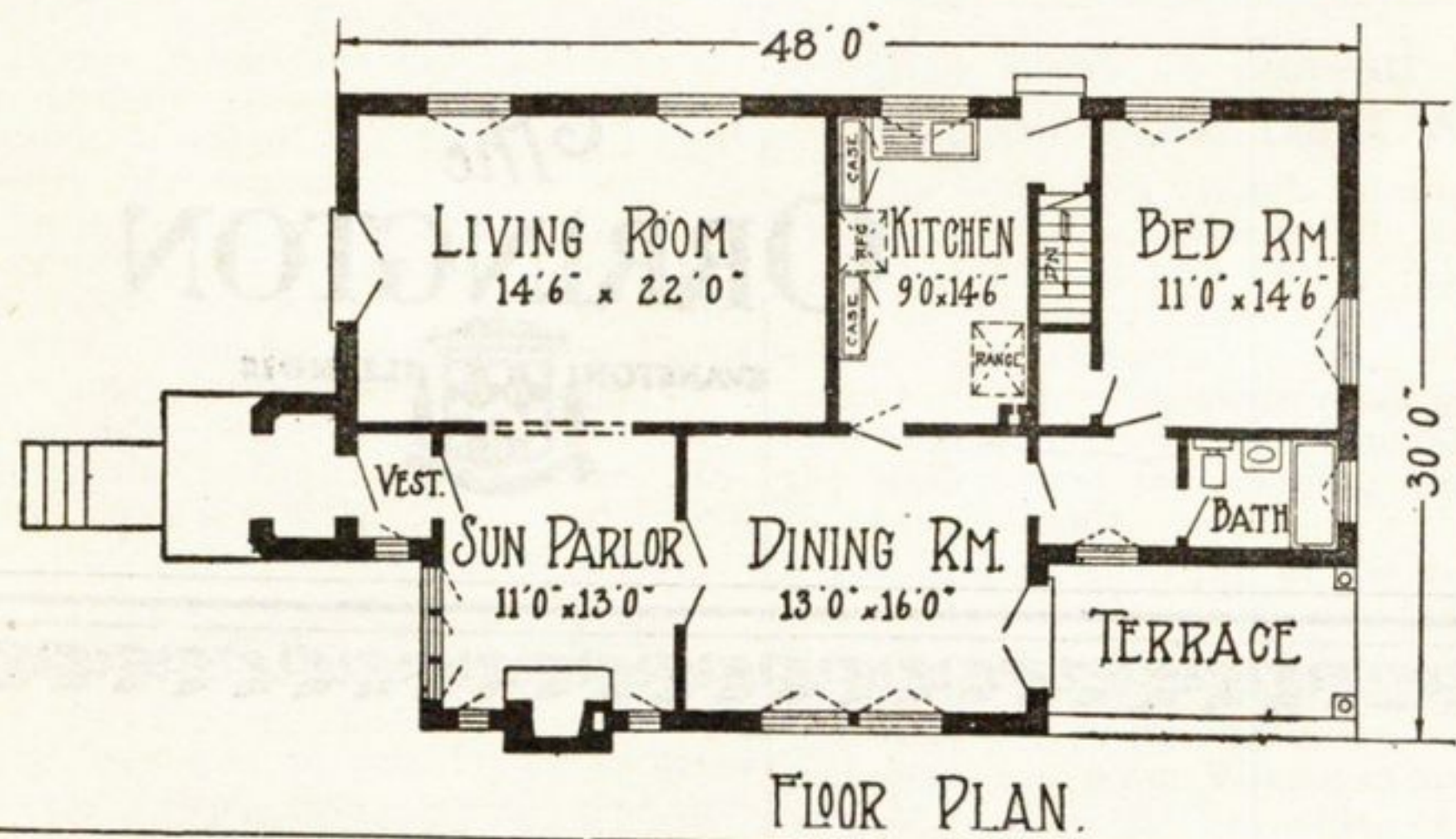
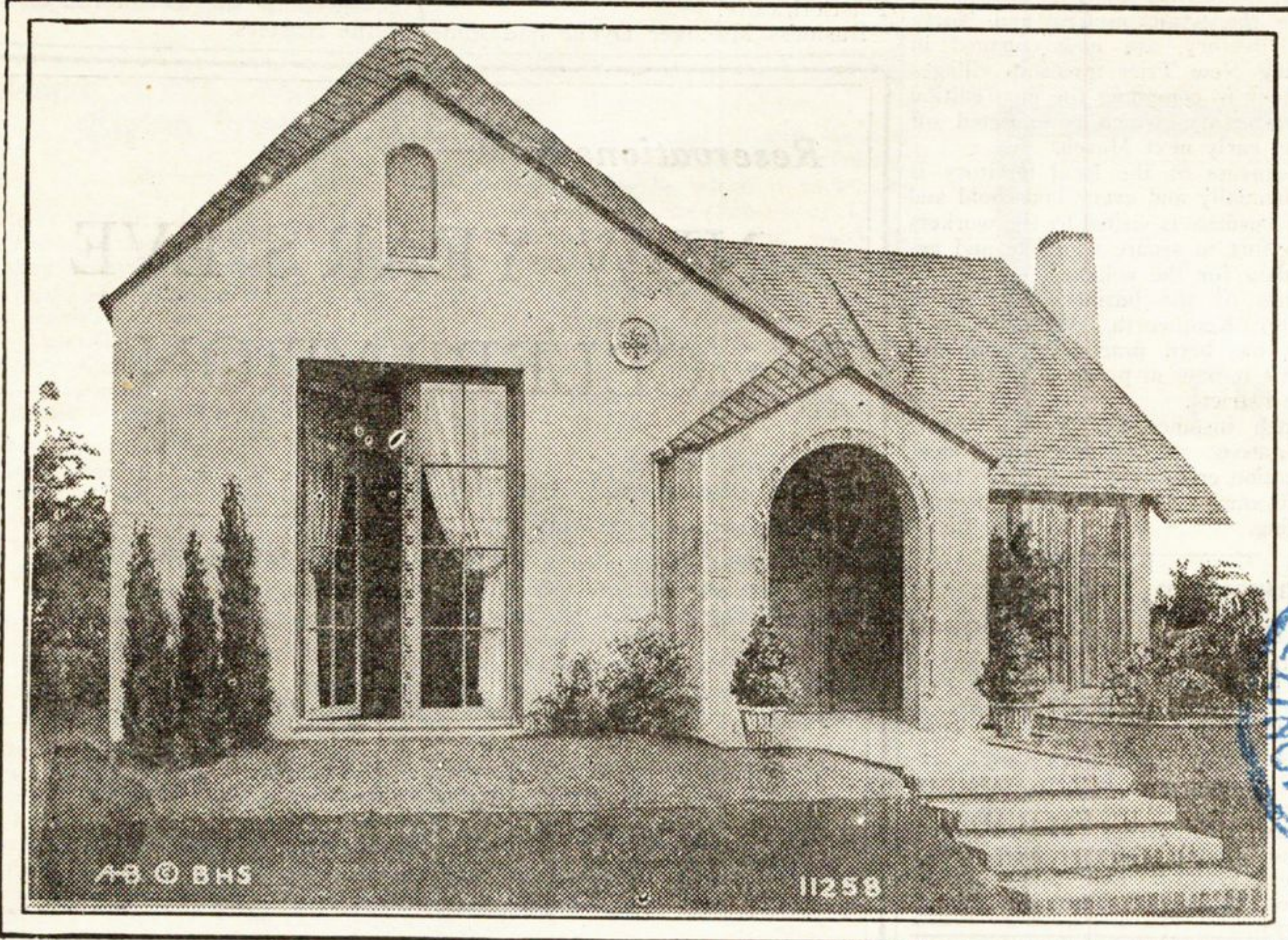


Quaint Cottage Home of Stucco

Dean Peter C. Lutkin and Administrative Director Car. M. Beecher of the Northwestern University School of Music, will attend the Music Teachers National association meeting, which will be held at St. Louis, December 29 to 31. Dean Lutkin is one of the councillors of the association and is on the committee for the fiftieth anniversary, which will be celebrated next year. He has been twice president of the association, in 1911, when the meeting was held at Ann Arbor, and in 1920, when it met in Chicago. At that time, the association was in rather serious financial difficulties and Dean Lutkin was largely instrumental in getting its affairs on a more substantial basis.
