"You and I" is a play which falls into the strictly modern division of the drama. It was written two years ago, and produced for the first time in New York in February of 1923, with H. B. Warner as Maitland White. After a long run as a Broadway hit, "You and I" came to Chicago last year, where it again scored a great success.

H. Spaulding Coffin, of the cast of the North Shore Theater Guild's most recent offering, "Fashion," will be seen in the part originated by H. B. Warner. Miss Genevieve Teuton will play the charming wife opposite Mr. Coffin. Charles Fleischmann and Dorothy Taylor, prominent young actors of the north shore, will act vis-a-vis when they assume the ingenue leads.

The human appeal in "You and I" probably accounts for its great popularity. They are two distinct plots running through the play; one just as interesting as the other. First, there are the affairs of Maitland White, which deals with the conflict of his business success and his artistic longings; and then there is the wholesome love story of Ricky and Ronny. These two themes are interwoven so cleverly, that a completely coherent story is produced.

The proceeds of this performance are to go to a fund which is being raised in order to erect a studio at the Peterborough Colony in memory of Anna Baetz, the nurse and friend of Edward MacDowell, America's greatest composer.

this Saturday, for we expect to give them a very interesting evening," says Mr. Schumacher. "The boys and girls are anxious that you purchase tickets and also attend, rather than that you merely buy tickets and do not attend. They want a full house and are looking forward to your coming."

Several numbers to be played this Saturday are being prepared for rendition at the Champaign tournament, among them overtures from "Martha," "Fra Diavolo," "Panorama" and "Admiral." There will be a mixture of classical and popular numbers.

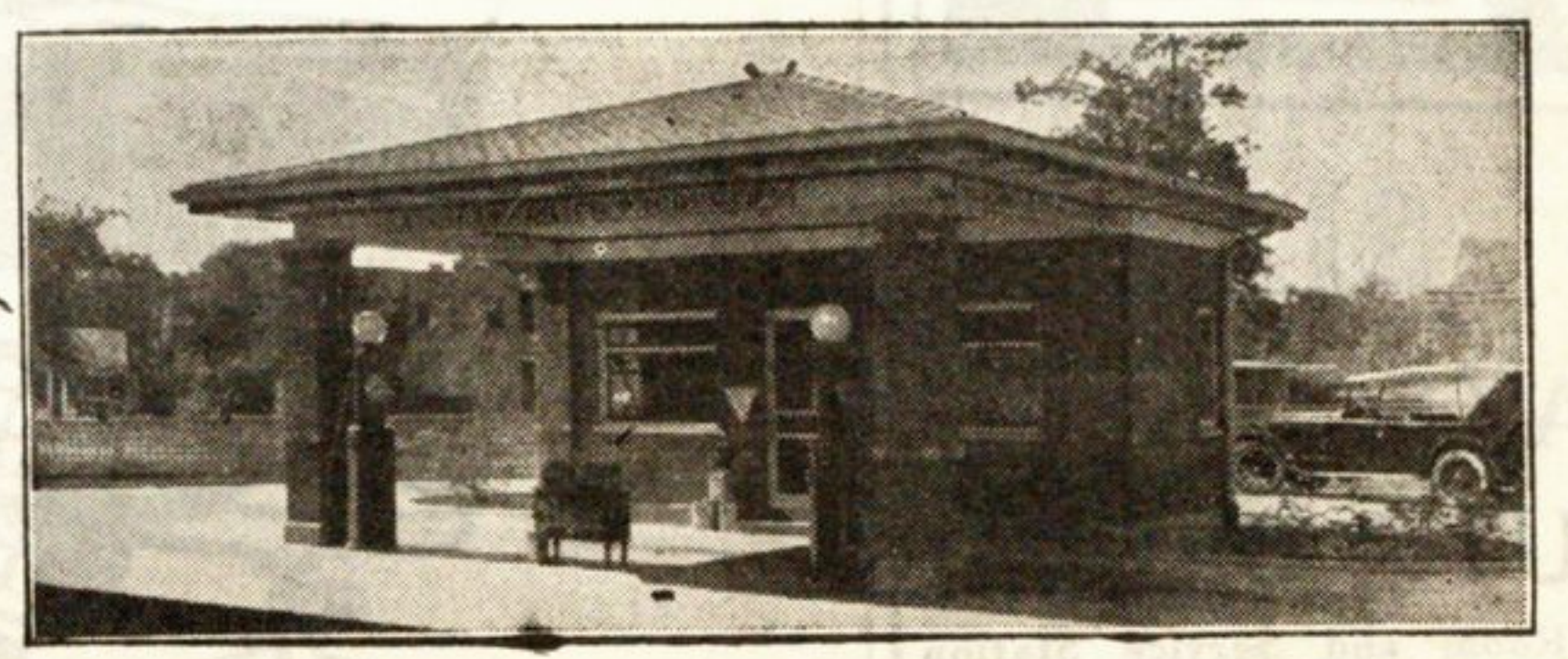
