**Home-Builder, Here's Where Your Money Goes**

Out of each dollar expended for the construction of a home 81½ cents are used for construction, including materials and labor, according to a brochure just issued by the Copper and Brass Research association. Carpentry involves the greatest amount, 27.2 cents, and stucco, plaster and tile work is second with 10.8 cents. Masonry requires the expenditure of 9.4 cents from each dollar.

Other construction costs are itemized as follows: Excavating and grading, 1.8 cents; roofing, 5.4 cents; flashings, gutters and downspouts, .7 cent; plumbing, 9.3 cents; heating, 7 cents; wiring and fixtures, 2.7 cents; hardware, 2 cents; painting and glazing, 4.5 cents; screens .9 cents.

Of the remaining 19½ cents the cents are divided as follows: Landscaping, 3 cents; builder's profit, 9.4 cents; architect's fee, 4.5 cents, and financing, 1.6 cents. This analysis is based upon actual construction costs of nine houses ranging in price from \$9,100 to \$23,000 and averaging \$15,000.

**Building Grants Increase With Beginning of Spring**

Glencoe builders are erecting a number of new homes, permits for which have been taken out recently. Thomas J. Simpson is building two homes, one of stucco construction at 1021 Eastwood avenue, and one frame and shingle at 989 Eastwood avenue, each to cost \$18,000.

F. A. Cooper, also, is erecting two houses in the village. A frame and stucco residence at 562 Stonegate terrace will cost \$12,000 and a frame, stucco and brick house at 850 Valley road is to cost \$12,500.

The most expensive house for which a permit was taken out this week was a brick veneer residence which H. W. But-

ler will build at 322 Vernon avenue at a cost of \$24,600.
