

**NEW TRIER IS SECOND  
IN TRIANGULAR MEET**

New Trier high school finished second in the triangular track meet with Thornton and Riverside held on the local track Saturday morning. Thornton won the senior division with 58 points to New Trier's 57, while Riverside trailed along with 16. In the Junior meet, Thornton had 58 3/5, New Trier 40 1/5, and Riverside was a poor third with only 6 1/5. Thornton won both meets by virtue of their great strength in the field events, in which New Trier has not had much practice.

Mills of New Trier easily won the mile, finishing 40 yards in front without extending himself. Sanders won the 880 from Teeple of Thornton, who had beaten him in one of the indoor meets. Mills showed his versatility by placing third in this event.

Phil Brown won the quarter in 56 seconds, his best time of the year. Sanders fought his way to third place, which is remarkable considering that he had already won the half.

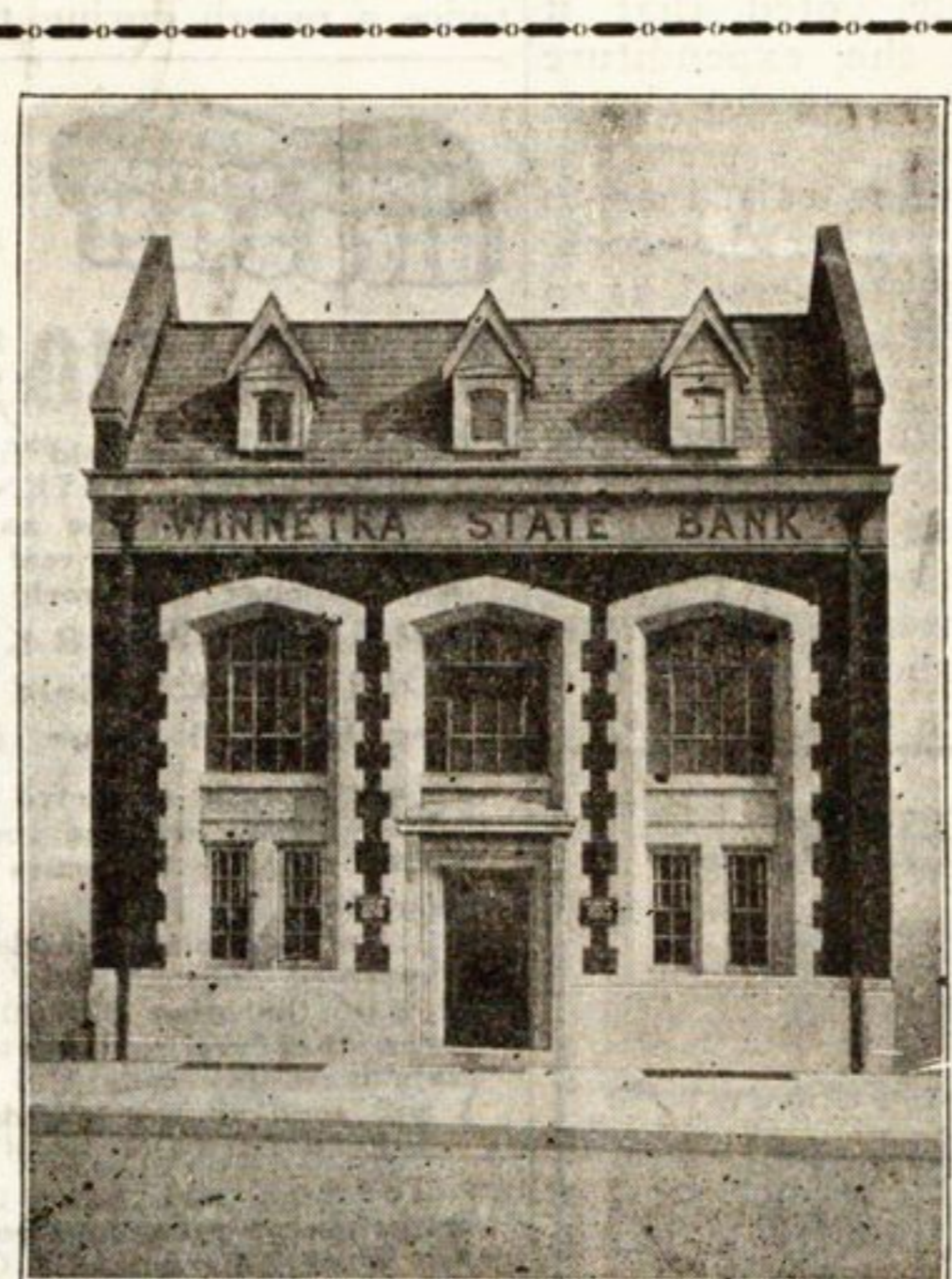

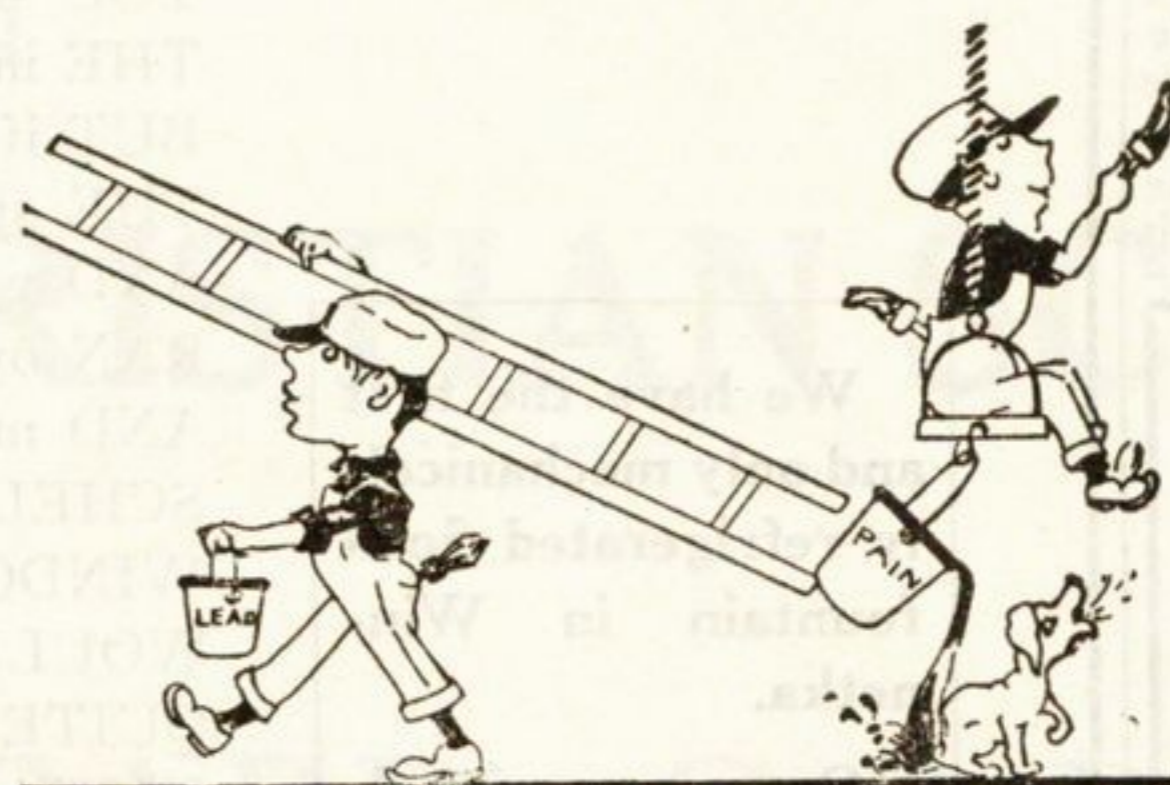
