"The Educational Screen" says, "Constance Talmadge, engaged to three men and in love with a fourth, is at her amusing best in this cheerful tale of a girl who fell in and out of love as easily as she breathed. Antonio Moreno plays handsomely the stern guardian who finally marries the heroine." It is decidedly Miss Talmadge's picture. She carries the comedy clear to the end with great delicacy."

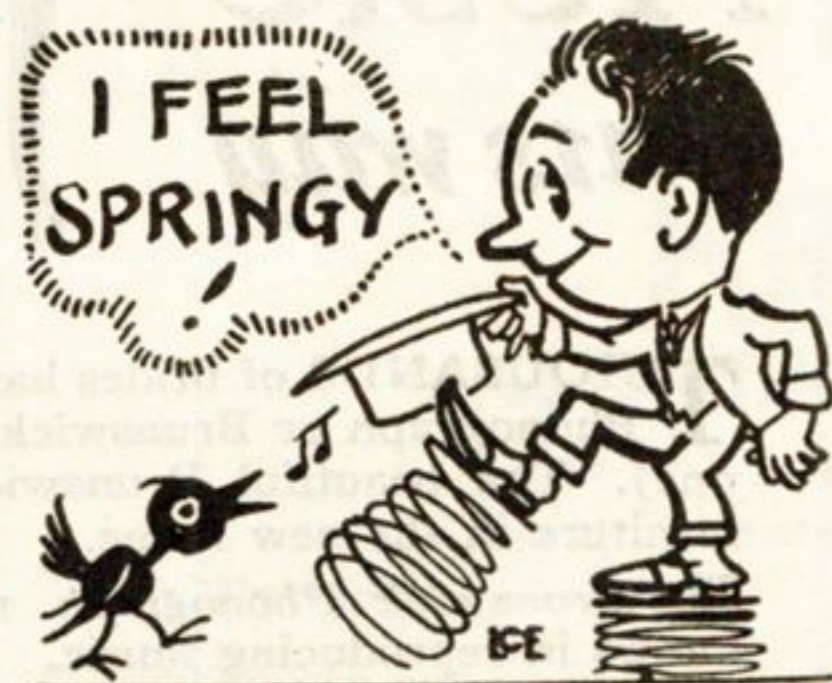
Winnetka Girl Receives Degree at Smith College
