self-corrective materials—games, etc.—enable the children to teach themselves and eliminate much of the recitation work. Thorough diagnostic tests show the teacher where each child stands and just where he needs help, and the time saved from recitation can be used for giving this individual help. The teacher spends her time teaching, rather than marking, and there is time for group and creative activities which give an opportunity for the development of character, initiative and self-reliance.
