
CHOSEN DEAN OF "Y" SCHOOL

Winnetka Man Directs Commerce Branch

J. A. Humphreys, 809 Elm street, Winnetka, has just been elected dean of the School of Commerce of the Central Y. M. C. A. schools, according to announcement of J. R. Short, chairman of the board of governors.

Humphreys has been secretary of the personnel service bureau of the "Y" schools since last fall and before that was in the advertising business. He has also been principal of the Intermediate school of Winnetka. He is a graduate of Oberlin college and did his graduate work at the University of Chicago.

The School of Commerce, which Mr. Humphreys is to head, is affiliated with similar Y. M. C. A. schools throughout the country and has worked in close cooperation with the Chicago real estate board, Association of Credit Men, Associated Advertising Agencies, Investment Bankers' association, and other similar organizations in preparing and giving 41 different specialized courses in commerce. More than 1,000 men were enrolled in these night courses last spring. A large development of the school is anticipated under the leadership of the new dean, who feels there is a great need for practical commercial training for boys and young men, who are willing to work all day and then invest their evenings in self improvement.


Owners are not even asked to remember when the next lubrication-inspection is due. A small label, attached to the face of the speedometer, tells them when the next visit to the service station should be made.
