PICTURES FIRE DANGER IN HOME

State Fire Marshal Gives Home-Owners Advice

Men will guard closely their places of business against fire hazard, but are prone to neglect their homes and families against those same dangers, declared John G. Gamber, Illinois state fire marshal, in a talk before the Wilmette Rotary club this week.

"How many homes, for instance," the fire official asked, "have even the precaution of a single fire extinguisher? Yet statistics show that 80 percent of the victims of fire ravage are women and children-most of them presumably safe in the homes or schools."

Mr. Gamber, in citing several great fire catastrophies of the past two decades, showed that, in virtually every instance, the deplorable tragedies were attributable to the carelessness of one or a few persons.

On the subject of oil burning devices for the homes Mr. Gamber, in declaring that oil heating has come to stay and would eventually supplant coal for home-heating purposes, added that of the 300 or more oil-heater devices on the market today only about 25 had September in time to see Miss Louise been approved by the fire underwriters. He cautioned the users of oil burners to take great care in selecting the best grades of oil and to avoid these of the heavier density. Grades of oils to be used are specified by the underwriters, he said.

Every community should enact an ordinance regulating the installation of oil-heating devices, the marshall declared. Proper installation, and safe storage of oil are important as a safeguard to the home, he said. Oil, if in large quantity, should be stored underground and brought to the heating plant by means of a hand pump, he suggested. It was his opinion that gravity feed was often unsafe.

"Look after your furnace in the fall, before you start the fire," was Mr. Gamber's parting advice. "You wouldn't let your car stand idle all winter and drive it away in the spring without first going over it thoroughly. Then why not take the same precaution with the heating system in your home? Autumn brings most of the fires because of failure to inspecting heating systems.'


