Details of the ceremonies will be announced later.

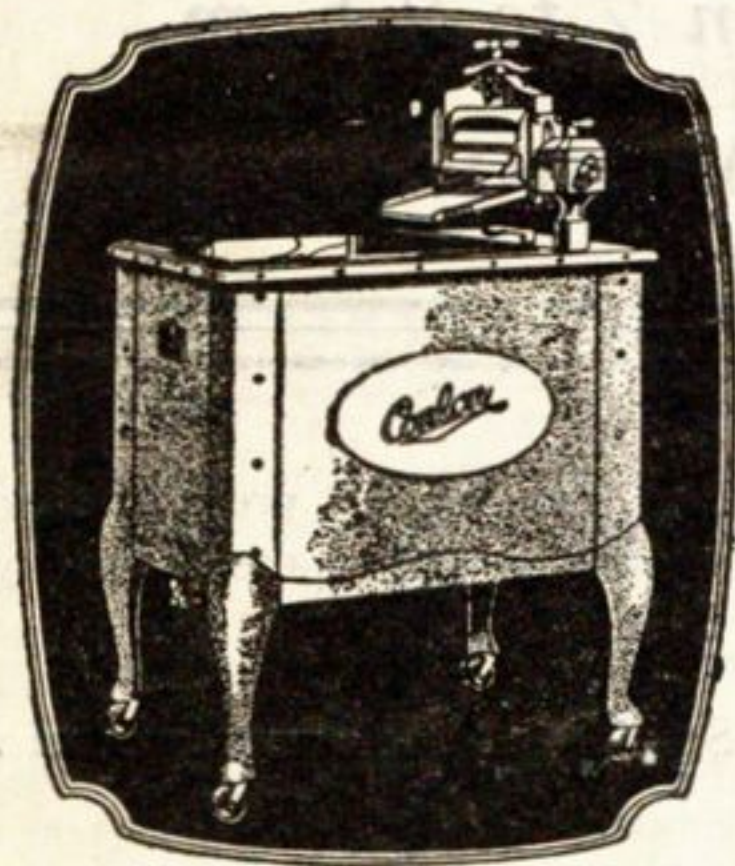
### Chamber of Commerce Band Gives Concerts

### Sea-Plane Newest Craft to Enter Wilmette Harbor

Among the latest arrivals at the Wilmette harbor this week is a new flying boat, the property of Wellington Quirk of Evanston. This craft, brand new and direct from the government factories, arrived last Monday at the harbor and was given a try-out Tuesday afternoon. It has a Curtis eight-cylinder V-type motor, which is said to drive it at a speed of 100 miles an hour. It uses from 12 to 14 gallons of gasoline an hour and carries a supply of 42 gallons, which gives it quite a cruising radius. The plane will accommodate four passengers. Mr. Quirk will keep the plane at the harbor and use it for pleasure trips.

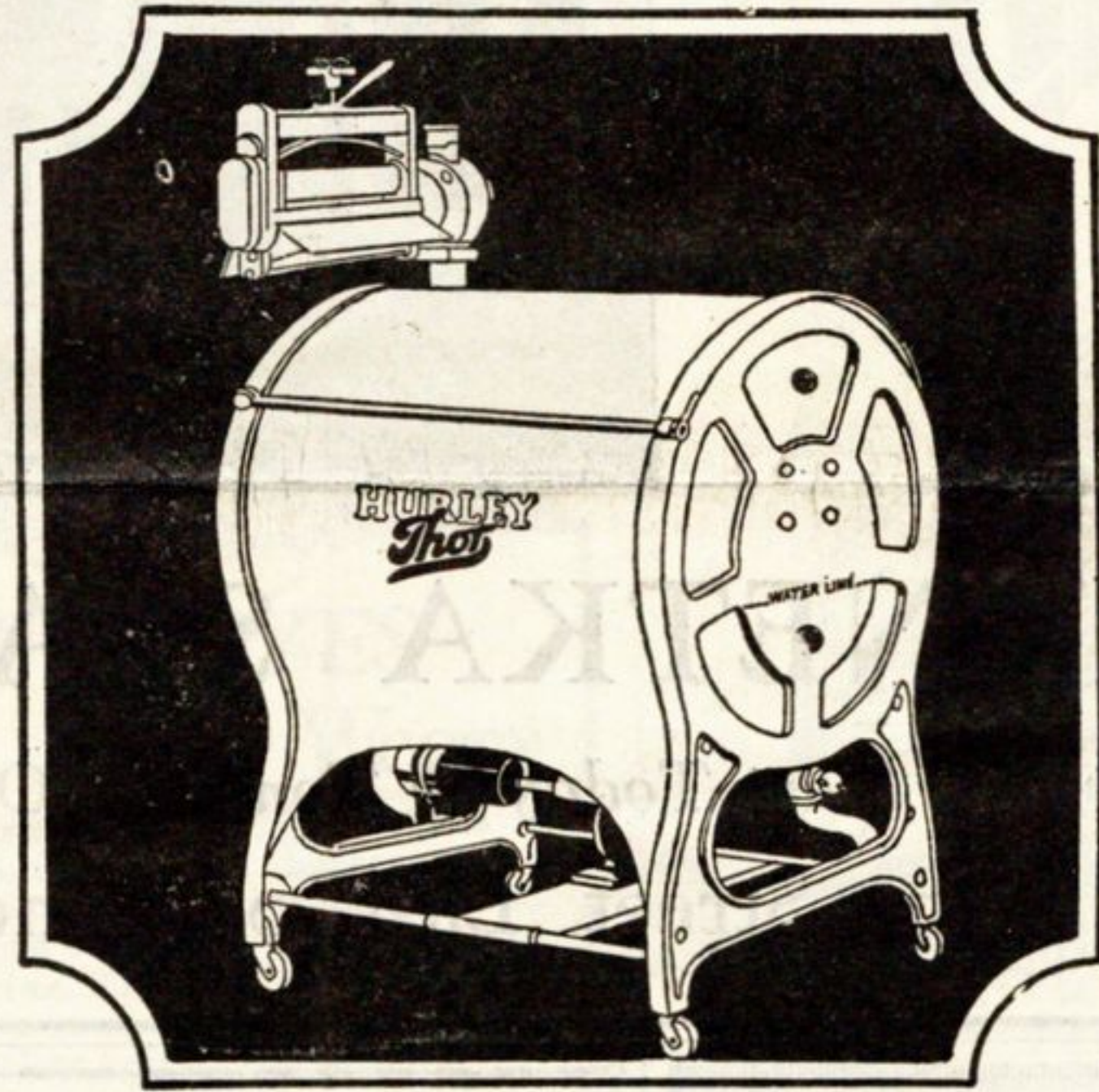
