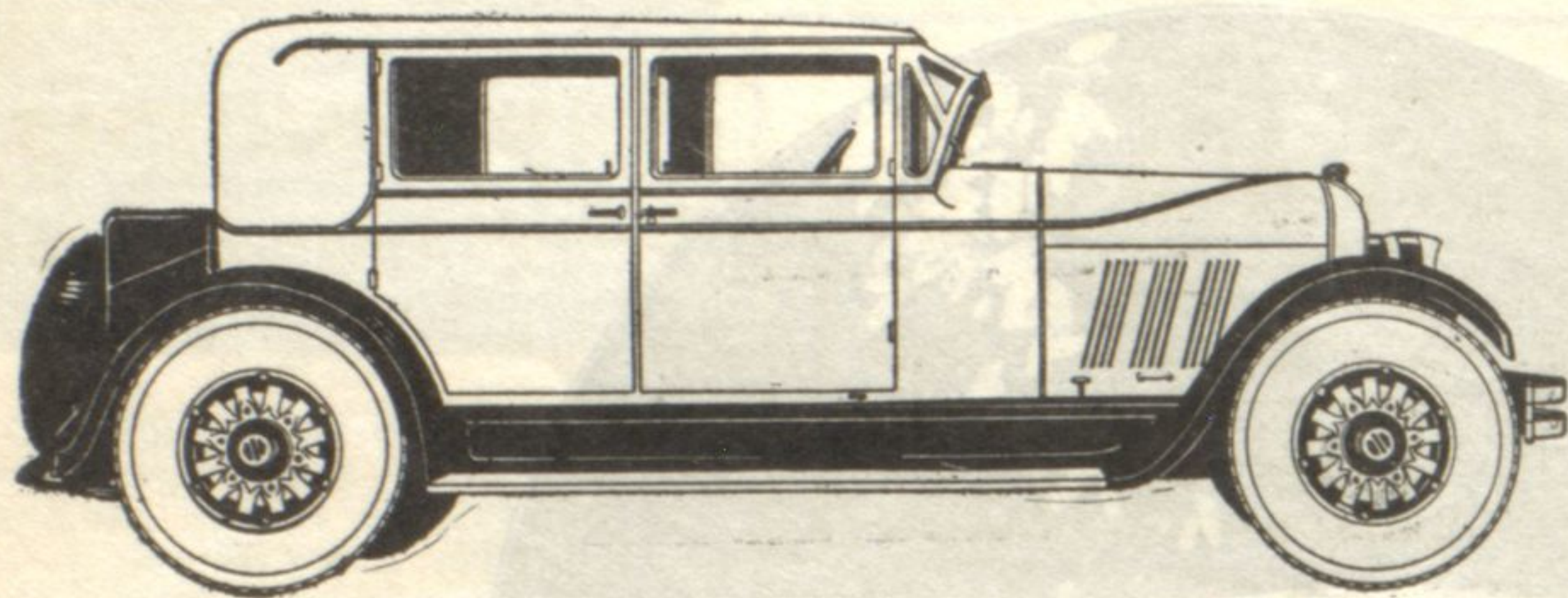
### Soccer Champs Prepare to Renew Victorious Exploits

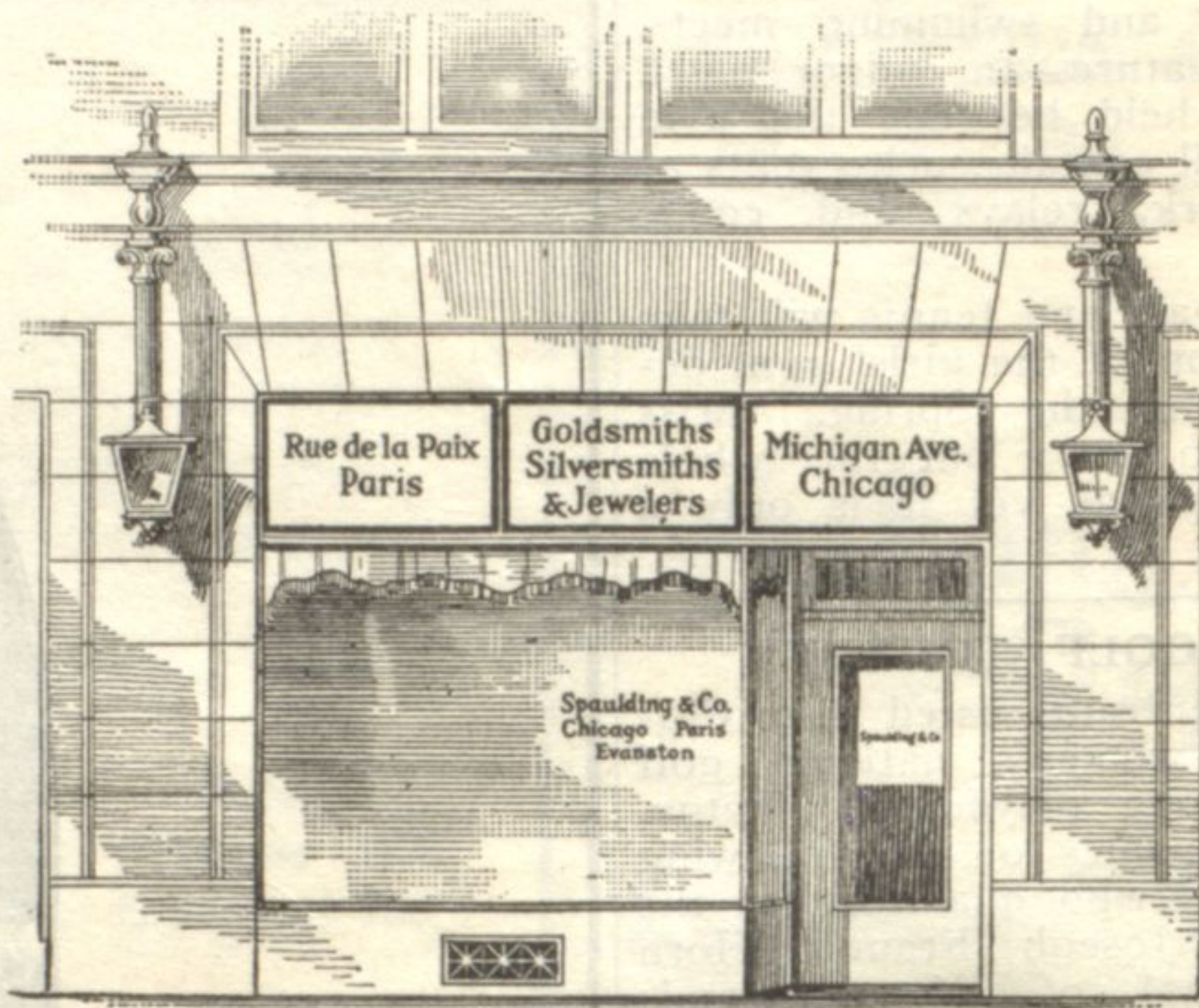
