When a pupil has accumulated 10 demerits he is referred to the adviser chairman. This is said to be one of the advantages of the new system in that it establishes a firm basis upon which to determine when to bring the pupil to the attention of higher authorities.

The system is to be conducted in the form of a contest among the boys' adviser rooms of the various classes. The room having the lowest percentage of demerits will be ranked the highest of its class.
