On this occasion, women public officials and official women representatives of leading party groups, will be present to take part in the discussion.

That afternoon, a tea for new women voters, those just of age, will be given by Mrs. John V. Farwell at the Woman's City club. Young women students in the various colleges, universities, and normal schools in Illinois, are invited that they may have an opportunity to become personally acquainted with the organization devoted to the political education of women.
