

**Winnetka Woman's Club to Hear Talk by Florence Frank**

The Winnetka Woman's club will hold its next meeting Tuesday afternoon, November 17, under the auspices of the art and literature committee. Preceding the regular program at 2:30 o'clock, Miss Mary Hewes, head librarian at the Winnetka Library, will give a 10 minutes talk on "The Library and Children's Book Week". Following the talk, Miss Hewes will have on exhibition a number of attractive new books for children and will be glad to answer any questions pertaining to appropriate books as gifts for children.

Florence Kiper Frank will give the program, her subject being "Certain Tendencies in American Poetry". The club welcomes Mrs. Frank, not only as a talented member of our own community, but also as a poet and playwright of distinction among the younger writers of America. Her verse and short stories have appeared in various magazines and she is the author of several one-act plays which have been produced by the Provincetown Players of New York.

A volume of her verse, entitled "The Jew to Jesus, and other Poems" published in 1915, contains a lyric beauty which has a personal and appealing quality. In the recent anthology of verse called "Modern American Poetry" some of Mrs. Frank's outstanding poems appear.

Besides discussing American contemporary poetry on Tuesday, Mrs. Frank will read some of her own poems.
