The majority of young women offenders are arrested for moral offences. Miss Binford feels we should be more patient and understanding in handling these cases and make a thorough investigation of the conditions that bring about the downfall of these girls. She also urged more institutional care for the slightly feeble minded.

A benefit for the League of Woman Voters to be given at Woman's club on November 12.

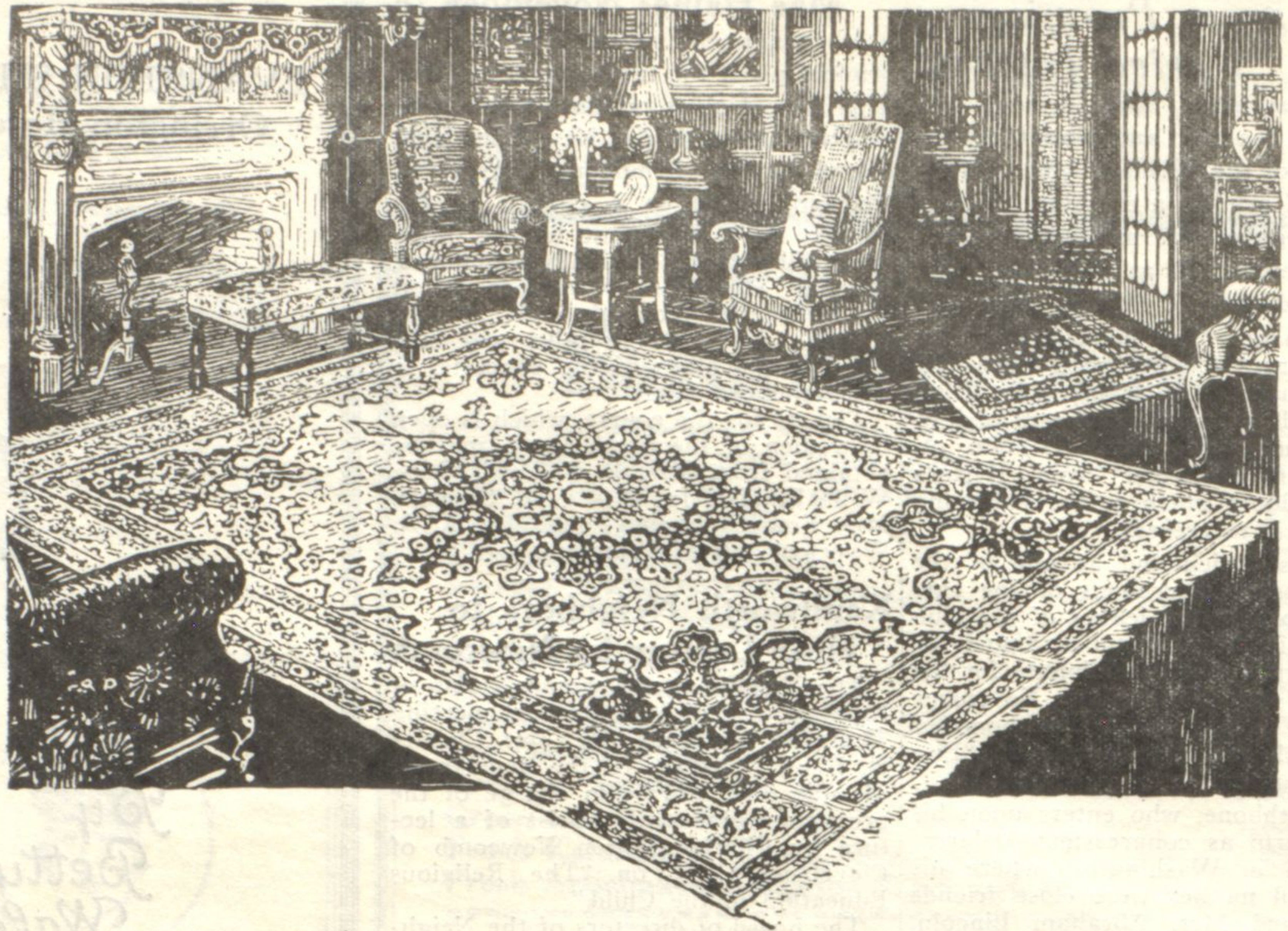
Mrs. Willoughby Walling and Mrs. E. S. Rogers have been appointed Red Cross delegates.
