

Find Real Estate Transfers Showing a Lively Activity

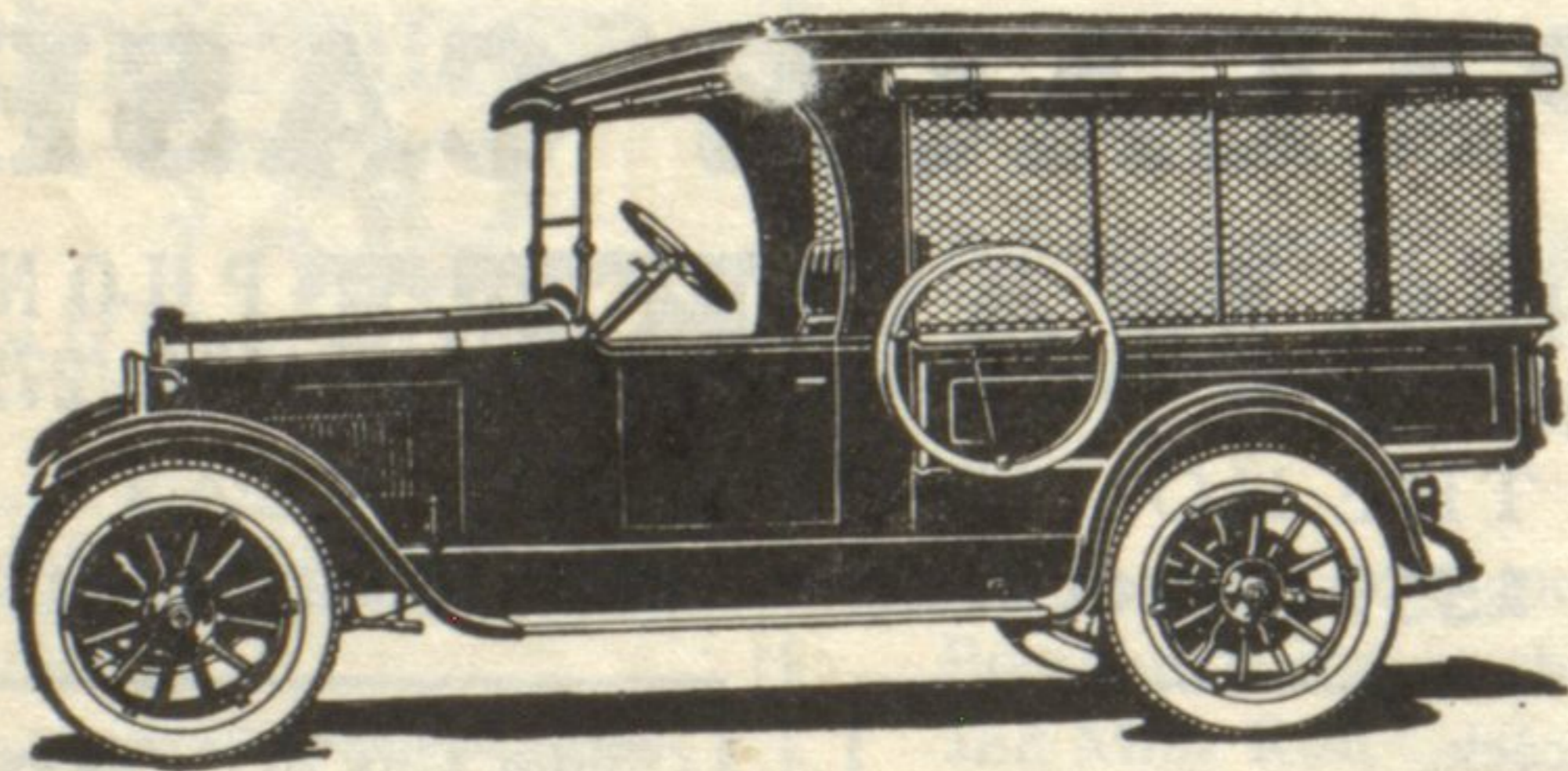

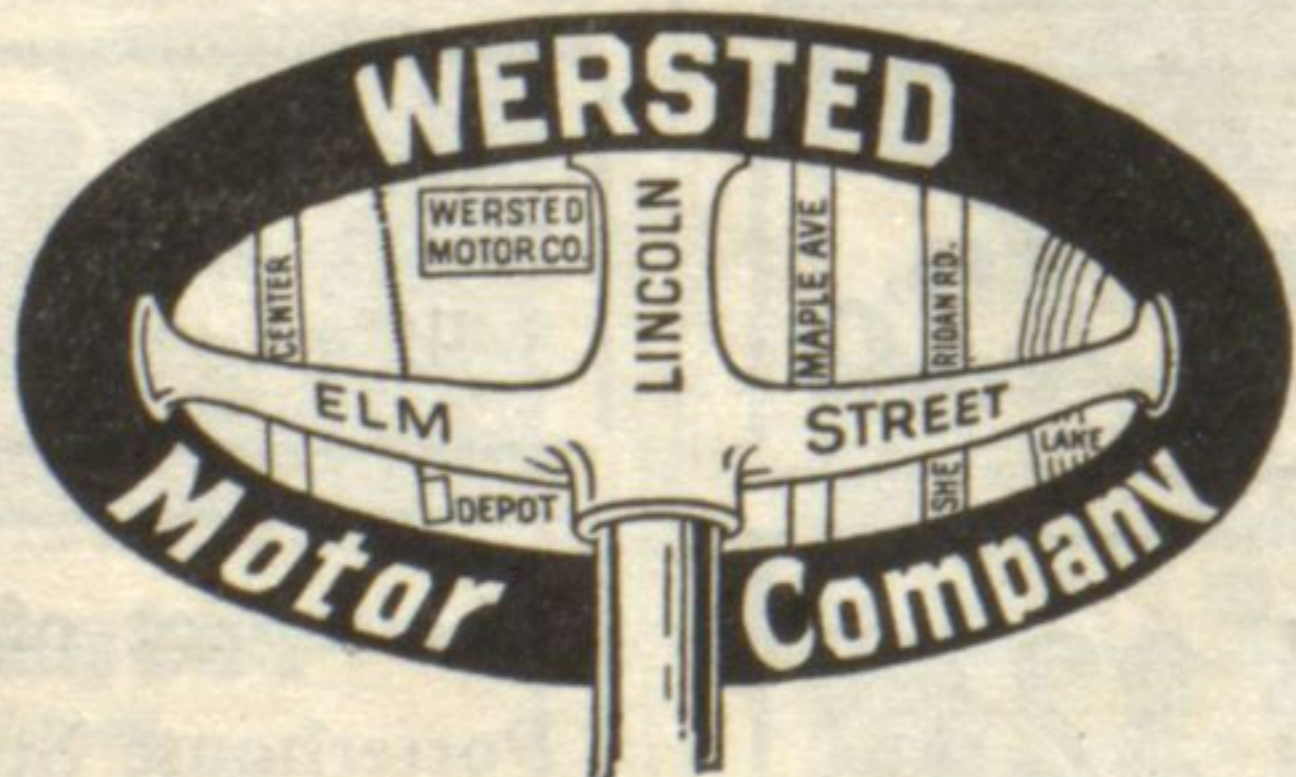
